The Callicoon Tractor Parade rolls into its 27th year on Sunday, June 11. Historically on the second Sunday of June, the Tractor Parade kicks off at noon and will continue down Lower Main Street before ending in front of the Delaware Youth Center (DYC) in Callicoon.

The annual tractor parade is a staple event and often brings thousands of people from all over the county and beyond to Callicoon, so be sure to arrive early if you would like to find parking in town!

Event coordinators ask that you follow the rules, and that parents keep a watchful eye on their little ones as the more than 200 tractors parade around town to the delight of one and all. There is no fee to participate in the parade, however the DYC will happily accept donations of any amount.

In addition to the parade, the Callicoon Vol. Fire Dept. is hosting its annual Pancake Breakfast from 7 a.m. until 11 a.m. at the firehouse and the DYC will also be holding a BBQ immediately following the event at the Delaware Youth Center. Tractor Parade t-shirts – a true collector's item – will also be on sale all day. All proceeds go to support the DYC.

Check out the Callicoon Farmers Market from 11 a.m. until 2 p.m. or maybe even see what is playing at the Callicoon Theatre.

Enjoy the charming hamlet of Callicoon, which has something for everyone.

Kratzes to headline parade

embers of the Delaware Youth Center board often refer to one of the grand marshals of this year's tractor parade as the Youth Center historian.

It's a fitting name. Clarence Kratz has volunteered on the non-profit board for some 40 years now, ever since his own children were young kids who used the facility to roller skate and swim. Those kids are now parents themselves, and Kratz's grandkids have likewise used the Callicoon facility created decades ago to provide youth of the Callicoon community a place of their own.

Still, Kratz stays on the board, he says, because it's his way of continuing to serve his own community.

"It gave me a sense of personal accomplishment being able to support the community the best way I possibly could," Kratz said of his tenure on the board. STORY AND PHOTO BY JEANNE SAGER

And now the center that he's given so many years to is honoring Kratz, naming him and wife Loretta as this year's Tractor Parade grand marshals.

It's a tribute that's fitting not just for their combined years of service to the Youth Center — Loretta also volunteered for several years on the board — but the Kratz family's deep roots in the local agricultural community.

Clarence Kratz was raised on the site where the couple now live in the hills above North Branch, a site that was then a working dairy farm. His father was the fifth generation to work the farm that dated back to the 1800s.

After high school, Clarence Kratz joined the US Navy while Loretta, who had moved to the Callicoon area as a young girl, left for college. Married a few years later, the couple eventually returned and set down roots, both working a number of jobs before finding the

jobs that would define their careers. Loretta spent years at the Monticello Raceway, eventually taking over as director of party packages, while Clarence worked for the New York State Department of Transportation.

In 1983, they purchased a small store in Hortonville, running Kratz's Kountry Korner for a decade as kids Erik and Kristine grew up.

While Clarence volunteered at the Youth Center, Loretta was elected to the Delaware Valley Central School Board of Education, serving 15 years.

Their service was important as parents, Loretta said, but that was just a piece of it. "It was not only for our kids but for the kids in general in the community," she noted.

It's a spirit that drives the many volunteers at the Youth Center, Clarence said, and it's one that's brought people out time and again over the years to help keep the non-profit facility alive and open.

"There'd be times where we'd be \$500, \$600 in debt, no fuel in the tank, and someone would make a donation or Tamarack hunting club would hold a function or the Hortonville Fire Department would hold a ball tournament, helping us out," he explained. "Pinpointing names ... you'd have a book of people who have volunteered."

Those people keep him coming back too, and he's honored as much to be among them as he is with the honor of leading this year's parade.

"I enjoy the people I work with there and the rewards that come out of everybody's effort, theirs more than mine!" Clarence noted.

Those efforts will be on display once again at this year's volunteer-run parade. After all, it's a fundraiser for the non-profit where Kratz has given so much of his time.


