

Thousands of hippies came to Woodstock Festival in 1969 and one from Texas never left.

We introduce "Duke" Devlin who tells his tale, "I hitchhiked from Amarillo in '69 with a friend for three days of peace, love and music. The claim was 'You'll breathe air that's never been breathed before'. In the chaos I was separated from him, helped clean up the site after the music and wandered into Bethel. It was the hospitality, the beautiful, kind and friendly people I encountered that made me stick around. Hector's was my home base and one thing led to another. I got small job offers so I could support myself. Things just kept coming up. I thank G-d, because for a lifetime, more than 50 years, it's still a beautiful place to live and breathe."

The area has many priceless things to offer. We are flush with wild wilderness, our "Upstate" forests, lakes, rivers and crystal clear water. There are parks and hidden spots where a person can meditate, relax, or hike. You have your choice of accommodations besides the "family's place" with an array of inns, short or long term rentals and camping.



The Club is open to members and their guests seven days a week for a 10- week season, generally from July 4th through Labor Day. Memberships of more than 100 families come from varying walks of life: businesspeople, artists, lawyers, teachers, retirees,

## **Bethel History**

own of Bethel, N.Y., one of fifteen towns in the center of Sullivan County, measures over 93 square miles, includes 4.6 miles of water, and 147 miles of road. Ninety miles northwest of NYC and southeast of Binghamton, it is located on the watershed between the Mongaup and Delaware Rivers. Local government is lead by a Supervisor with a four person Town Board. The recent census recorded a population of 4362.

The first inhabitants in the territory were the Leni-Lenape Indians. 1795 records state that the Pintler brothers were the first settlers. Bethel separated from the Town of Lumberland, incorporating in 1809 with Briscoe, Bushville, Fraser, North White Lake, and Stephensville as the earliest settlements. The current land map consists of Bethel, White Lake, Kauneonga Lake, Smallwood, and parts of Mongaup Valley and Swan Lake.

Hunting, tanning and fishing were the original industries and naturally, due to the rich land suited to farming, agriculture followed. Bethel is still considered an Agricultural community today.

It was not until the mid-nineteenth century that the tourist industry developed. Inns and summer camps lead the way in the 'Golden Age' for area hotels, second home development, and the hospitality industry. The Concord, Grossinger's, Kutsher's and a variety of "Borscht Belt" hotels dotted the area map. Holiday Mountain Ski Area,

the 'Mighty M' Racetrack, and SC International Airport became operational by the '60s. The Woodstock Festival, Bethel's claim to fame, put the town on the map in 1969. The number of resorts diminished in the following years, however second homes and seasonal visitors kept the Catskills alive.

To our delight, Bethel Woods Center for the Arts and Museum opened its doors in Bethel in 2006. The exclusive Monticello Motor Club, Resort World Catskills Casino and The Kartrite Resort and Water Park attractions made Sullivan County their home in the last decade.

In 2019, Woodstock's 50th anniversary, the countywide Dove Trail was created, with Bethel extending the trend with The Heritage Trail, depicting Woodstock highlights. Antique, Crafts, Farm, Maple Syrup, and Craft Beer, Wine and Spirits Trails have popped up in our area and throughout New York State. We are also home to segments of the popular walking and hiking Trailkeeper and Rail-to-Trails.

All of this and the desire to "get out of the city" has enticed visitors and new homeowners.

The Town of Bethel continues with technology improvements, solar arrays, and environmental development. Parks and Rec can boast about the Dog Park, Forest Reserve at Smallwood, area park facilities and lake and waterway access.

Today, our town promotes business, second home and tourist industry growth and a green, sustainable lifestyle.

Bethel is idyllic. We offer open space, fresh air, various bodies of water and a welcome to a relaxed, country life.




