The Cabin

he Cabin is a Catskills and Sullivan County landmark. A true hand-hewn log cabin built in 1971, it's nestled in the woods at the edge of a horse pasture where three country roads meet. A local hangout for beers, drinks, wings and burgers for decades, The Cabin is an everyday hometown bar and restaurant that makes guests feel warmth and at ease with its casual and comfortable fire-lit environment and the rugged mountains as backdrop.

The inviting hunting lodge feel with its taxidermy, antler chandeliers, cabin relics and hunter green waxed cotton seating coupled with the aged original logs and beams and a wood burning stove glowing in the heart of the cabin are just some of the authentic details that set the tone for this diamond in the Catskills rough.

Looking out over the horse pastures, fields and wind-

ing country roads, you can imagine how much (and thankfully, little) has changed over the course of The Cabin's history. Snowmobiles line the roads in dead of winter leading to an intimate thriving pub with inspired music, sports on the screens and dollar bills covering the ceiling, gathered and dispersed when a local person or family is in need. The Cabin continues the tradition of bringing locals and visitors together to drink and dine with a menu of classic cocktails, beers, quality homemade dishes and rotating seasonal specials.

Wings, burgers and steaks remain core to the offer along with a variety of entrees, appetizers, sandwiches and salads.

The hand built log cabin still stands today thanks to the community who frequented it as a favorite watering hole amongst workers, neighbors and town folk, and as a dinner spot for couples and families. Over the years as the demographic changed with city transplants, the cabin drew an eclectic cast of locals and visitors alike. The unifier has always been the sense of being home away from home, and that life is better at the cabin.

The Cabin has witnessed more than fifty years of Catskills' history. On Wednesday, February 1, 2023, a

new chapter commenced with the opening of The Cabin and the continuing of its legacy.

Picking up where the families before left off, a local family are the new owners shepherding The Cabin through its next evolution, working closely with its members of the original crew to mold and continue The Cabin's story into the future.

Rafting on the Delaware River is relaxing, fun and full of great sites, from eagles to beautiful vistas.

he 35th Annual Family Raft Trip sponsored by the Upper Delaware Council will take place on Sunday, August 6. Public reservations are due by Friday, July 28.

The 2023 river section to be paddled is a scenic six-mile stretch from the Staircase Access in the Town of Lumberland, NY to Kittatinny Canoes' Matamoras Base in Westfall Township, PA.

Kittatinny Canoes will provide the rafts, paddles, life jackets, safety instructions, and shuttle transportation.

Plan to arrive between 9-10 a.m. at 1147 Delaware Drive in Matamoras to park and check-in. Guests will be shuttled up to the Staircase Access to launch.

The average length for this trip is 3.5 hours, depending on the water level and the group's desired pace. This segment of the Upper Delaware Scenic and Recreational River offers Class 1 & 2 rapids, with stretches of quiet pools. There are multiple sets of rapids at Staircase, Mongaup, Butlers Rift and Mill Rift. Participants will paddle beneath cliffs and spectacular rock formations, through lush vegetation then reach the dramatic gorge known as the Hawks Nest and go under the No. 2 Railroad Bridge.

Minimum occupancy per raft is four people.

Pack a picnic lunch and plenty of drinking water. Dress to get wet, wear sunscreen and foot protection, and avoid bringing valuables. Small coolers and waterproof bags for items such as cameras and keys may be tied into the raft.






