



# 81 Class of 2023 graduates celebrate in Fallsburg



"I'm sure most of us are feeling all kinds of emotions right now," she said looking around. "Excitement, sad-



acknowledgement of senior awards. At the conclusion of the ceremony, attendees were invited to meet the graduates in the gym for photos and to celebrate their momentous achieve-




Grace Hernandez, President of the Class of 2023, highlighted the various challenges the class faced over the past four years in her opening remarks. The biggest challenge they faced, of







loving families have driven their success.




