

fter some renovation and designing, Sonia Jozaitis and Jason Thomon opened High Voltage in the cozy hamlet of Mountaindale back in December of 2018 - a kitchen and bar serving comfort foods that burst with flavor excellence and that often change with the season - but just a little more than a year after they opened, the pandemic hit.

So Sonia and Jason got creative. They created the High Voltage Creek Bar to help with responsible social distancing and to keep people outside in the fresh air, and although life has mostly gone back to pre-pandemic, the Creek Bar has stuck.

"We wanted to create something that felt like it belonged in the mountains," said Sonia and Jason.

And they absolutely did. The Creek Bar is seasonal, but the High Voltage indoor dining experience is open year-round with stools at the bar, cozy tables, and a large booth by the front window. Sonia and Jason created a unique vibe with taxidermy and vintage items on the walls. Hand-painted signs outside point you in the direction of the Creek Bar - down the side alley, past a flower garden, through a wooden gate, along a wood chip path with little string lights leading the way overhead to an open wooded area complete with tables, lounge chairs around a fire pit, wooden stumps, a stage for live music, and a vintage



In the evenings the table is moved and the stage for live music comes alive. Local craft beers and cocktails are available at the Creek Bar, or enjoy an intimate night with wine inside High Voltage.

Local craft beers, cider, cocktails, wine, and coffee from Brooklyn's Partners Roasters can be ordered at the Creek Bar, along with your food choice like the Trout Toast, the Gordita's Style Tacos, or the Brekkie Sandwich. You're given a little buzzer and when your food is ready you head up to the High Voltage food window.

A new roof over the Creek Bar and a few of the tables was recently put up due to all the rain we've had here in the Catskills, so that the outdoor vibe can still thrive even on those overcast days.



The sweet booth at the front is room enough for a party of friends or family, with one of the coziest vintage chairs you won't want to part with just across the room.





## a perfection of platters, pots, etc.

otter Jessie Lazar has had a little studio in Eldred for about three years, renting it shortly after her and husband Crandall and daughter Lula moved up to their vacation home in Yulan during the pandemic, but recently, Jessie moved into a new, much larger space that can support a growing community of artisans, which is now Sullivan Public.

"My pottery studio [Studio Jessie Lazar] is on the far side of the building, and the center is my shop that is always open," said Jessie pointing to shelves and tables boasting beautiful pottery, and clothing racks with vibrant vintage items. "Everything else is a pop-up. The Second Sunday of each month we feature other artists and vendors, as well as workshops. It's a community hub and art space."

Pottery was something Jessie had always been interested in, but it wasn't until a friend bought continued on page 30

her a gift certificate to take a class in 2003 that she truly fell in love with the art.

"It's something that you can't just jump into and get, you really need to practice, so I spent all of my free time working at it."

The studio where Jessie was honing her craft, eventually gave her the opportunity to teach a class, and everything seemed to blossom from there.

"I had no intention of doing it professionally but then I did a little craft fair," smiled Jessie, "and it just morphed into this thing that I was wholesaling to boutiques in the city as well as different shops in the area, and teaching classes."

Pottery was a pivotal moment in Jessie's life and career. She even met her husband at the studio she began at.

Since she and her family moved to the area, Jessie hasn't been teaching, but now that she has a space, she can start again she said. Her

first workshop will be held on Saturday, July 22nd from 4 to 6pm.

"I miss community, and I miss growing. Teaching makes me better, and making work with other people is a really important part of art," Jessie stated, "so now I have a space to house all that, and to have visiting potters too."

And Jessie's work reflects who she is and what she likes to focus on.

> "I really like sitting with a ruler and making a lid that fits perfectly. I find that really satisfying. I'm not great at embracing the imperfection of things, but I'm a pretty studious, technical person," she said looking towards her work. "There's a meditative quality to making pottery but my work isn't like that. It's very precise. So things that exercise that muscle are my favorite things to make."

## try to imagine better

he Delaware River is the longest free flowing river in the Eastern United States, flowing for 282 miles along the borders of New York, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Delaware before emptying into the Delaware Bay and eventually meeting the Atlantic Ocean.

Although the river is a water source that provides for many, if you ask anyone who lives along or close to the river, it's a life source.

Here in the Catskills, the Upper and Middle Delaware is a part of our river valley, hosting one of the largest populations of wintering Bald Eagles in the northeast, along with waterfowl, warblers, osprey, hawks, shorebirds and more. The beaver and the river otter also call it home, as well as black bear, white-tailed deer, muskrat, and Canada geese along its banks.

The River is a sanctuary for wildlife all around, but it's also a sought-out fishing destination, and a paradise for campers, swimmers, rafters, canoe-ers, and kayakers during the summer months.

Both locals and visitors alike have their favorite swimming holes or boat launches. Some enjoy the peace of sitting by the water at their river-front property, while others tube float for the majority of the afternoon in groups, laughing and chatting along the way.

Whatever activity you choose, remember to practice safety, as the river is not just a source but a force. There can be undercurrent not seen to the eye, rocks not visible from above, and depths unknown.

And however you like to enjoy the river, remember to respect what's around you. Leave the river wild and clean, because it's a life source for creatures we have yet to meet


