



ack in 1999, Rochelle Beck made the change to quit her corporate job in the big city and buy a 52 acre property with a boarding house then owned by famous photographer Joel Meyerowitz - with a future dream of opening a Bed and Breakfast, restoring the house to its original purpose.

Located up on the hill in Jeffersonville on the backside of Bethel Woods' Center for the Arts, the original house on the property was built in 1860 and was enlarged in 1905 to serve as a boarding house for visitors coming up from New York City. With joy and inspiration, she and husband, Mark, worked to renovate the house and officially open it to guests in 2012, becoming Bethel Pastures Farm Bed and Breakfast.

Since then, due to both Mark and Rochelle's love of camping and wish to share their growing hobby farm with guests, they added four cozy 12x12 cabins on the property where guests can stay, hike, help on the farm, visit the local town, or



The sheep and chickens are free-range so you just might get to see them grazing in front of your cabin while sitting out on the porch. Each cabin is cozy and sweet, with plenty of light, fresh country air, and everything you need for comfort with a camping feel.

just hang out on their porch and enjoy the view.

The best part? Getting to hang out with the sheep.

"Our flock are Shetland sheep," said Rochelle beaming as she walked up the continued on page 12

path that trails through the 52-acre property with several sheep running behind her. "They're a very old breed, a primitive breed. They think that vikings brought them to the Shetland Islands in Scotland. So they're a very hardy, small breed which makes them easy for me to handle, and their wool is fabulous - it ranges from fine to coarse depending on the animal itself."

Each morning, guests have the option to help round up the sheep and go on a walk with Rochelle to move the herd to another paddock at the back of the property. Guests are invited to participate in all farm chores from feeding the sheep and chickens, collecting eggs in the morning for breakfast, to harvesting flowers and helping in the garden. And if you're at the farm in the Spring season, you might just get to be a part of the shearing process or witness a lamb being born.

"Last year we hosted an event and sheared them on Memorial Day weekend," explained Rochelle. "It was a great experience. We really love hosting guests, especially having the kids here so they can learn about the animals "

According to Mark, a retired school teacher, they are also now offering virtual farm tours to schools.

Although they no longer offer rooms inside the farmhouse, the cabins have everything you need to have a fun camping experience with comfort. The "Cabin with a View" accommodates 4 with a gueen bed on the main floor and 2 twin beds in the loft, while the "Ruffled Feather Cabin" has a king bed that can be made into two twin beds. Each cabin has running water, an outdoor hot shower, a fire pit and grill, towels, a gift certificate to the local Jeffersonville Bake Shop, and more.

"Guests can also collect eggs for breakfast at their cabins as we provide pots and pans, dishes, utensils, any-






or decades the brick walls of a pump house built in 1881 for the Ocean Bayonne Oil Pipeline stood hidden behind overgrown vegetation and thickets of weeds along State Route 97. Abandoned, scraped for steel in the 1930s and left roofless, it was barely detectable from the road.

All that changed three years ago when Dave Lieber and Jin Zhang purchased a three-bedroom house along with the property and its abandoned building.

What began as "Dave's Backyard Skewers" - while clearing away continued on page20 The Pump House has a big presence with a beautiful backdrop, and is lit up at night while still being able to see the stars. trash, overgrowth, and envisioning what the abandoned space could be turned into - has quickly become an iconic Catskills community hub.

In 2021, the Cochecton Pump House was re-established. An open-air venue featuring a variety of beer and wine, and for this year's 2023 season, an Asian street food Think Lumpia (Filipino Pork Spring Rolls with a house-made sweet chili sauce), Coconut Curry crispy cauliflower, and Spicy Korean Chili wings. Main dishes like the Pump House Burger, Pork Banh Mi, and Chicken Adobo, and side dishes like Pickled Cucumbers, Garlic Fried Rice or Cold Peanut Noodles.

But the Pump House is so much more than just a seasonal one-of-a-kind restaurant. It's a place to gather for screenings, exhibits, performances, pop-up events, live music, and the occasional dance party. It's unique, it's fun, and it's worth a visit on a sunny summer day.




