a place to make memories

Fall is often the preferred season for weddings in the Catskills with cool, breezy nights and warm, golden sunny days. Life starts to quiet down and the leaves begin to change while wild flowers are still sprinkled throughout the fields.

At Handsome Hollow, a wedding venue and grounds tucked away on 93 acres of meadows, fields, fern forests, and mountain views in Long Eddy, the season of weddings also includes a rustic, nearly 300 year old barn and farmhouse.

“To this day, I still don’t know

exactly how everything happened,” laughed owner Kate Murphy, sitting down at the table on the farmhouse porch. Behind her, the sun was glistering on the roof of the barn while the breeze blew through the trees.

The Handsome Hollow wedding barn, she says, was a working dairy barn until the Spring of 2014 on a property upstate near Albany.

“My husband and I bought this property back in 2000 because we wanted a place to be outside with our kids. The farmhouse was in really bad condition and needed a lot of work, so it became a proj-

ect for us,” she explained, “but the property was stunning. Throughout the years we always wanted to do something more with it, and that’s when I saw barns for sale online.”

Kate proposed an idea to her husband, who worked in film and she in advertising, to get the barn, and to make it into a wedding venue to host weddings.

“He told me it was a terrible idea,” she laughed, “and then the next morning he changed his mind and said, ‘you know, wedding barns apparently are a thing.’”

So in early 2014 the company selling the barn, dismantled it, fumigated it, re-enforced it, and by October the timbers were delivered and the frame was assem-

bled on site in just 10 days. Over the next eight months local craftsmen worked on the barn and the grounds, bringing it to completion in July of 2015.

“Not long after, we hosted our first wedding,” Kate said, scooting her chair back to stand up. “Let’s go look at it.”

Walking into the barn, you can smell the sweet scent of wood that has been standing tall and strong in the sun for decades. With all the original posts and beams, you can see saw and hammer marks from its initial construction. Touching a post is touching history. The barn has soaring ceilings and large sliding doors on three sides giving the

feel of being a part of the outdoors while being sheltered from the sun, the wind, and the rain. With over 4,000 square feet of space, the barn comfortably seats 200 people.

Two bathrooms are to each side of the lower level, while stairs made from the barn's original floor lead up to a lounge loft that overlooks the venue. A full commercial kitchen, banquet tables and vintage wood chairs, two bluestone cocktail patios and a large bonfire surrounded by Adirondack chairs complete

the package.

Walking from the barn to a pathway through the trees, there are three ceremony sites to choose from: the bluestone ruins of the original property's barn, a clearing in the forest surrounded by ferns and maple trees, or a mountain view in the middle of an open field. All of which surround you with nature, and make for unique and magical photos.

And let's not forget the late 19th century farmhouse, which is one of the first things you see when

you arrive, and where it all began. When renovating the farmhouse, they made sure they kept all of its original details while also giving it a clean, contemporary feel. There are two oversized bathrooms to get ready in, along with three simple, cozy bedrooms, a wood stove in the sitting room, a full kitchen, and a wrap-around porch.

“Sometimes it’s just the couple that stays here on the property,” said Kate, “and sometimes it’s the bridesmaids and the bride. It all depends

on what the bride and groom want.”

Kate, her husband, and her team make sure everything is just right, from fresh flowers in the vase near the window to firewood stacked in the shed outside.

“After all these years and all these weddings, the thing that I love the most, is seeing how happy both the couples and their friends and family are at the end of a weekend,” said Kate looking out over the property. “It just feels really nice to know that all of this has brought so much beauty and joy.”

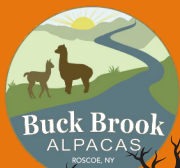

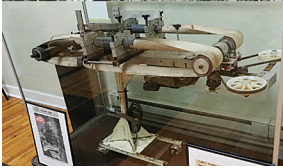

have your cake...

Nearly two years ago, Heather DeGori took the jump and launched Cuppie Cake Desserts, a bakery specializing in birthdays, dessert bars, “just because” treats, and of course, weddings.

DeGori’s desire to bake started in 2012, but at that point it wasn’t anything serious. When she and her sister decided to take classes at Wilton School of Cake Decorating in Darien, Illinois, learning about cake decorating, gum paste, fondant, etc in early 2014, she realized it was more than just a desire. It was a passion and a love for what she was creating.

“From there, my sister and I started a business called K&H Confec-

tions, but she ended up meeting the love of her life and moving away,” DeGori said. “I was in college full time, working, and raising little girls so we decided

to close the business.”

It wasn’t long before DeGori felt the pull to revisit what she had left, missing baking and creating for customers, so she rebranded and Cuppie Cake Desserts quickly came to life.

“The inspiration behind the name was my kids,” smiled DeGori. “Some people said the name seemed childish since it’s a play on cupcakes, but to me it just reminded me of why I started this business and why I work so hard.”

DeGori runs the business solo, but has plenty of help from her mom and mother-in-law, often helping her with deliveries, grocery runs, and setting up the dessert bars.

Cuppie Cakes offers a variety of desserts from custom cakes and dessert bars, to monthly cupcake specials and cookie boxes. Recently DeGori has been hosting Cake & Sips, where you bring a friend and your favorite drink, while she brings the supplies so you can learn the basics of cake decorating. When the night is over, you get to bring the cake home.

Being a mother to two little girls, time management is key in what she does. Most weekends she has eight or more orders, so prep and understanding how many hours or days are needed for each step in the baking, decorating, and packaging process is crucial.

“Royal icing takes about 24-48 hours to dry,” said DeGori. “Baking time is about 30-50 minutes

for cakes, but then frosting can take 30 minutes or hours depending on the cake.”

One of her favorite things to bake, but also oddly has a love/hate relationship with, are sugar cookies.

DeGori aims for that crunchy outside and chewy inside - a clear sugar cookie taste with a kick of flavor.

She puts thought, passion, and experience into everything she bakes, including her popular wedding cakes and desserts, offering two different packages for the dessert bars, each with a different variety of treats for guests to dig into at the reception.

“I have so many fun ideas, but I think the best part is seeing people’s reactions to my creations,” DeGori expressed, “whether it be the design or the flavor. My dream is to have a traveling dessert bar, so we’ll see what happens.”

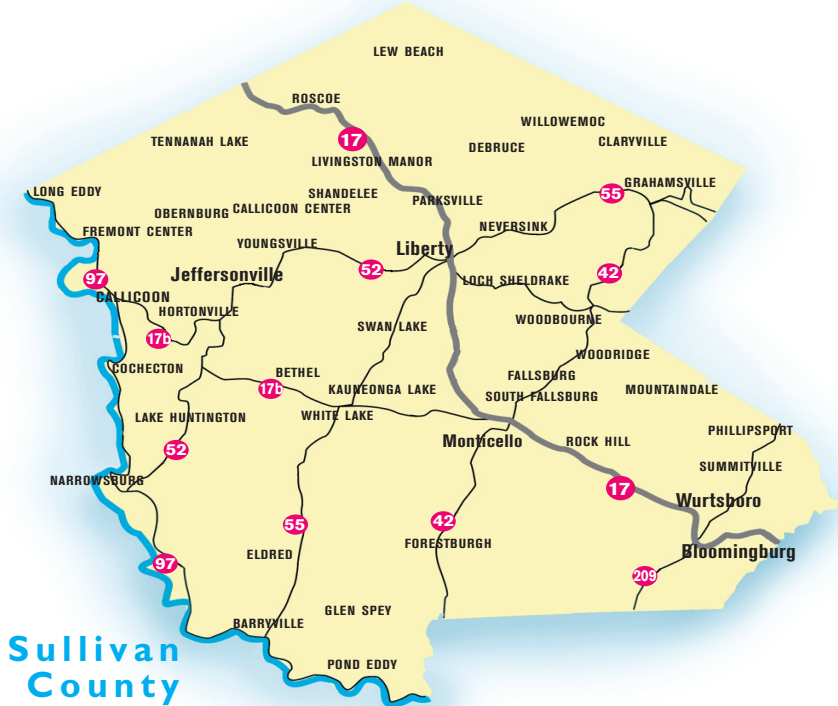
