Anyone who says "There's nothing to do" in the Sullivan Catskills needs to crack open this guide and "get cracking!"



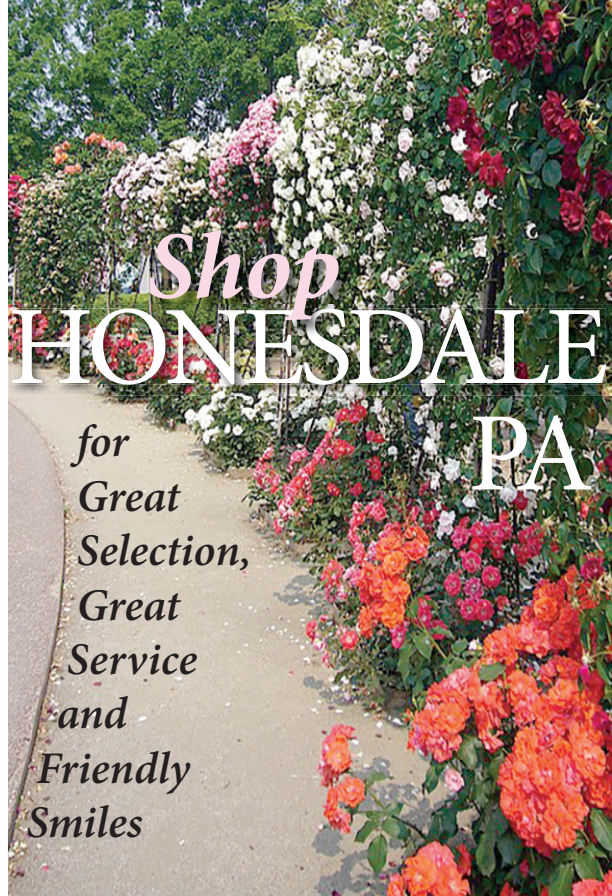

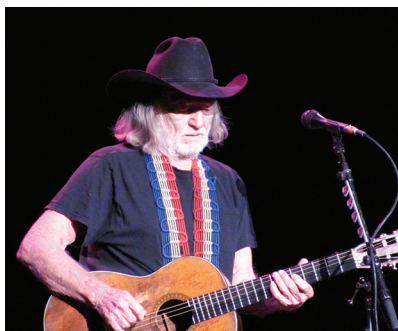
