

Stories abound about how bagels came to be, but we do know that they can be traced back to the Jewish communities of Poland, and before that Germany and Central Europe. Originally a type of bread roll, bagels are now one of the most popular items in the United States with more than 2 million bagels sold in the US each day.

And "The Bagel Capital" is right here in the Catskills. In 2013 the New York State Assembly and Senate officially decreed Monticello, NY as The Bagel Capital whether it's of the US, the world, or simply the state - it doesn't seem to matter, it's a destination for bagels, especially in August.

As the site of the original prototype of a 1968 U.S. patent-holding bagel-making machine that could make up to 600 bagels an hour, as well as the Monticello Bagel Bakery which is a local landmark and third-generation family business that makes an average of 25,000 bagels a week, Monticello is now also the site for the annual Bagel Festival.

From attempting to break records with the longest bagel chain, to a bagel triathlon, and plenty of bagels to sample and eat, the Bagel Festival is a unique and quirky festival of fun.

This year the festival will be held on Sunday, August 11 from 9am-4pm on Bagel Boulevard, otherwise known as Broadway in Monticello. It's sure to be a hole lot of fun! IULY/AUGUST. 2024





sticky fingers and where to get them

e've been waiting all winter and spring for this, often driving by our favorite places looking for the open sign hanging in the door or glowing red in the window. We've been holding back buying our familiar pints or cartons at the store in anticipation of cups and cones.

It's finally ice cream season in the Catskills, so bring on the rainbow sprinkles, delicious flavors, the it'smelting-too-fast, and the sticky fingers.

Inspired by the happiness ice cream brings (along with the sticky fingers) is Sticky Fingers Delectables in Kauneonga Lake, a petite ice cream shop tucked away by the water with bold, unique flavors and a mission for joy.

"Sticky Fingers was originally founded and opened in 2014," said now Owner and Proprietor James Loney. "I bought the business from the previous owners a little while after I bought my house in Smallwood back in 2017."

James had been working for Williams & Sonoma for years, and was looking for a return to a less stressful and bucolic way of life, along with the desire to bring happiness to people through food.

"My family comes from dairy farms in Ontario, Canada," stated James, "and thinking back to my childhood I felt a similar feeling each time I came to visit the Catskills. It felt like a second home."

So when James bought the ice cream shop, he quickly got to work making it into a "happiness factory." All the ice creams are made by Jane's Ice Cream of Kingston using some of the best hormone-free milk from New York State cows, along with natural and local ingredients for their flavors. You can get a cup or cone with classic favorites like Vanilla, Strawberry, Chocolate, and Mint Chip, give your tastebuds a zing with the Cappuccino Kahlua Calypso, Salted Caramel Pretzel, and Cinnamon Crumb Cake, or branch out and try flavors that are unique, delightful, and delicate like the Apricot Orange Blossom or Lavender. Top them with sprinkles

of your choice, crushed walnuts, or the home-made hot fudge and whipped cream made by James himself.

The smooth and completely dairyfree sorbets are also made by Jane's of Kingston with simple de-seeded and de-fibred whole fruits.
