162nd Annual Wayne County Fair



The 162nd Wayne County Fair will take place August 2 through August 10 at the Fairgrounds in Honesdale, PA.

he 162nd Wayne County Fair will take place Friday, August 2 through Saturday, August 10 at the historic fairgrounds in Honesdale, Pennsylvania. The annual fair celebrates the region's rich agricultural history and includes various entertainment, farm shows, rides and food.

The 9-day fair includes fun

for all ages on its large midway which includes over 20 thrilling rides as well as an expanding kiddie land. Outside of rides, the fair's busy entertainment schedule includes a variety of thrill shows, harness, racing, fireworks, demolition derby, popular two-day monster truck show and free musical grandstand shows featuring national cover bands.

A fan favorite entertainment is the Rosaires Racing Pigs with multiple shows daily at 1:30, 4:00, 6:30 and 9:00 p.m. There are also free Small Stage shows everyday at the south end of the midway near the red metal Exhibit Building.

Farming meets fun at the Wayne County Fair with daily

agricultural events like horse, tractor and truck pulls, pedal pulls and a pony pull. There are also 4-H animal shows and judging each day of the fair, culminating in the 4H and FFA livestock sale on the last day of the fair on August 10 at the Livestock Arena.

The last day of the fair also features a big Glass Blown and Wood Carving auction at 5:00 p.m. at the Small Stage.

The Wayne County Fair has an affordable pay one price of \$12 per day per person that includes parking, small stage shows, most grandstand shows and rides all day. The pay one price does not include food, drinks, midway games and shows, demolition derbies or the monster truck show.

Half price admission is offered on Friday, August 2 and Wednesday, August 7 to senior citizens age 62 and older and active military and veterans. Season tickets are \$50 and include admission to the grounds only, not the rides. The fairgrounds open daily at 9 a.m., while the midway and rides are open from 12 p.m. till 11 p.m. and the exhibit buildings are open from 10 a.m. till 10 p.m.



4H program and Ag roots remain strong

ne of the key aspects and a staple to the Wayne County Fair as it heads into its 162nd year has been the consistency and growth of its agricultural roots, which includes its 4H program.

Each day of the nine-day fair includes some sort of 4H competition and livestock show which culminates in the the 4H and Future Farmers of America (FFA) livestock sale taking place on the final day of the fair on Saturday, August 10.

All livestock shows take place in the livestock arena in the front of the fairgrounds.

The livestock sale is an important aspect to the fair as the 4H kids who presented their animals in shows and competitions throughout the week learn the final step to raising livestock. That final step

being releasing the animal to be used as a food source.

There are many skills that kids learn in the 4H program that are key for their futures out in the world and surviving on their own.

The type of skills that they learn include learning about costs/accounting, amount of products to be sold, what to do if any animals get sick, how to go about selling their livestock and much more.

The livestock shows kick off with the 4H and FFA Dairy Show of all breeds at 10 a.m. on Friday, August 2. The breeds involved in the shows include goats, rabbits, sheep, beef cattle, lambs, swine, hogs, calves and market steer.

There are also non-market animals used for showmanship which includes an ultimate showmanship contest on Friday, August 9 featuring a scavenger hunt, demonstration and multiple species showmanship workshops.





long the midway of the Wayne County Fair, you will find plenty of entertainment, food, games, rides and more fit for all ages. For a pay-one-price of \$12, guests have access to all the rides and most entertainment on the grandstand and small stage.

The fairgrounds open at 9 a.m. before the midway and rides open everyday at 12 p.m. and remain open until 11 p.m.

A staple every year at the fair is the ferris wheel which gives fairgoers a great view of the entire fairgrounds when they ride up to the top. Bumper cars are also a popular ride for all ages every year. While a handful of rides return to the fair each year including the merry-go-round, there are others which change or switch on and off every year.
