

Each one of them dedicated years of their lives to be a part of something greater than themselves. They serve and protect the various communities, working alongside one another on large-scale incidents.

However, each responder is an individual, many with stories similar to mine. They all have families and lives outside of fire calls and turnout gear, and each brings a unique set of skills and personality to their department.

The fire service is welcoming, if you ever feel that you would



like to add to these departments' storied histories, reach out, stop by on a drill night or ask a member that you know some questions about what it's like being a first responder.

Maybe it's the calling that you didn't know was there waiting for you.

History of the Livingston Manor Fire Department

he Livingston Manor Fire Department has a storied history, which includes hosting the first ever SCVFA County Parade.

The department began all the way back in 1891, after a chimney fire began while spectators were watching winter flood waters form an ice jam along the Willowemoc River.

Dr. Dekay's house on Pleasant Street had sparks erupting out of the chimney, leading many to rush to the scene. Upon arrival, the fire had burned itself out, but the idea to start a Fire Club was just reaching its incipient stage.

The group formed the original "Manor Hose Company," which is now known as the Livingston Manor Fire Department.

Through fundraising efforts and community support, the first fire-house was built around the turn of the century. It was erected next to the Masonic Lodge by the firemen. The building, which still stands today, is now the Livingston Manor Free Library.

The O&W brought many to Livingston Manor during this time, and the town continued to grow as new residents and businesses were drawn to the area.

In 1910, the Manor Hose Company purchased a new hook and ladder rig and horse drawn wagon to be used for fires. The ladder wagon was pulled by the team of horses owned by Milt Ward.

To notify the firefighters of a fire call, someone would notify the extra steam engine operator to sound the steam whistle. This would alert the firefighters and the town that something was on fire, and would lead to Ward's horses racing off the hill into town.

Years later, in 1917, Livingston Manor purchased the first motorized pumper in Sullivan County, which could deliver a steady stream of water to a fire. The pumper was delivered on a flat car on the O&W train to Liberty.

In 1923, a second company began - one for each side of the train tracks. The Hoos Truck Company was incorporated in January 1924, and joined with the Manor Hose to become the Livingston Manor Fire Department.

By the late 1940's, the Livingston Manor Fire Department had added additional apparatus to their fleet, including two 1947 Mack Type 45 pumpers and a 1942 American Indiana.

A decade later, the O&W was no

longer in business, and a new firehouse was built on Upper Main Street, where it remains today. The original firehouse was donated to the library to use.

The department started into an early version of the modern fire service, in which training, equipment and resources have advanced into the present day. The equipment is currently on a 20-year replacement cycle.

In 2016, boht Manor Hose Company #1 and Hoos Truck Company #2 decided to merge into one company. The companies already shared a building and went together for calls, making the merger beneficial to both the community and the department who could now function as one company. The company is now known as the Livingston Manor Fire Department.
