
Koger Baker

Hi... I'm Roger Baker... an artisan/craftsman who is also the author of this fun weekly column in the Sullivan County Democrat called 'On the Road with Roger Baker.'

Traveling and criss-crossing Sullivan County's almost 1,000 square miles has been and still is very interesting... I never know what scene is going to pop up and inspire the next column. Anything from a single tree to a beautiful building with some cool history.

Living in an adjacent county insists that I cross the county line to enter Sullivan County, of which there are many entrances... one of these days I will compile a list of entrances.

I only take a handful of pics at a time to work from... which keeps the illustrations current and seasonal enough to be recognized in their timeframe.



My originals are the same size as the available prints... 49 sq. inches (7''x7'') which seems to be a very reasonable, manageable size to work with.

The art is mostly colored pencils and wash... however some other mediums wind up contributing (coffee, housepaint, woodstove ash... and maybe even a little breakfast).


Views from the road comprise the majority of the drawings... hence 'On the Road.'


