



# herbal passions

Emmanuelle Barry's love for herbs and wildflowers began when she was a young girl growing up in Paris, France, spending summers in the countryside with

her grandmother, surrounded by wild plants like linden, lemon verbena, chamomile and nettles.

Emmanuelle's mother also inspired her love of plants, through

her own love of lavender, filling their home and kitchen with its scent.

"I can still smell that lavender," she said with a smile, "and my grandmother was always making tea. I would follow her, learning how to collect the plants, so from a young age I always loved it, I loved nature."

When Emmanuelle and her husband lived in Provence, France for a year, she spent a lot of time in the lavender fields there, as well as visiting world-famous perfumeries. It was there that her commitment towards wellness became a passion.

"A few years ago I decided I would go back to what I really loved," she stated. "I went to an amazing herbal school, the David Winston Centre for Herbal Studies, and became a clinical herbalist. David Winston is a wonderful herbalist and very well

known in the herbal community."

Emmanuelle began working one-on-one with people and their doctors, doing care studies.

"When they have issues I work with their doctor, and with

them, to see if we can help with herbs," she explained, "with herbal plants, herbal medicine, to see if we can help with their imbalances or their issues.

For quite some time, Emmanuelle was simply experimenting in skincare because she loved it. She was

making things for herself and for friends, and had wonderful results.

"So I started to do my skin care and, well, it just took off from there. Emmanuelle's Skin Care & Wellness was born," she beamed. "It's all organic, it's all pure. ## a trail to unique refreshments

estled in a pocket of trees, amongst lavender fields, maple, and hops, stands Two Farms Brewing, a collaboration of passions between friends. Recently opened, it's already become a woodland destination for their small batches of meticulously crafted brews inspired by the ingredients that surround them.

Brewer Mike Bruestle and wife Shana have been friends with Kent Findley and Erika Malmgreen of Winterton Farms in Bloomingburg for more than a decade, and when Mike and Shana decided to move up to Sullivan County full-time, a collaboration between them all began.

"Kent and Erika have this wonderful farm and land. They grow amazing

products and make their own maple syrup. They do incredible things here, so after a little coaxing from them," Mike smiled, "we decided to start this project together, to build a brewery on the farm. We decided to take my hobby to the next level."

Mike has been brewing beer for about 15 years, first starting out in a small 10 gallon pot in Shana's apartment in Astoria.

"The first time, it came out terrible," he laughed. "The second time a little bit better. Each time it got better to the point where I was brewing my beer and I was bottling my product to give out to friends, and I got great reviews."

Each year Shana and Mike would host a party at their house for Oktoberfest with continued on page 22

So take a trip whether close or far, enjoy a Two Farms brew, sit by the fire, shop some products from Winterton Farms, and enjoy the season in the Catskills.






