experiences... all while fostering healthy communication, responsibility, and emotional growth," Nicole warmly expressed. "We're proud to help fill the high-quality childcare gap."



BETHEL HISTORY

own of Bethel, N.Y., centrally located within the fifteen towns of Sullivan County, is located ninety miles northwest of New York City and southeast of Binghamton. Bethel measures over ninety-three square miles, includes 147 miles of road and 4.6 miles of water on the watershed between the Mongaup and Delaware Rivers.

The first inhabitants in the territory were the Leni-Lenape Indians. 1795 records state that the Pintler brothers were the first settlers. Bethel separated from the Town of Lumberland and incorporated with five other early settlements in 1809.

The current land map consists of Bethel, White Lake, Kauneonga Lake, Smallwood, and portions of Mongaup Valley and Swan Lake. Bethel has a population of 4,367 and has grown at the rate of 3.09% annually since the 2020 census.

The Town is governed by a supervisor and a four-person council.

Hunting, tanning, and fishing were the original industries and naturally, with land suited to farming, agriculture followed. Bethel is still considered an agricultural community today.

It was not until the mid-nineteenth century that tourism developed. Inns and summer camps lead the way to the 'Golden Age' for area hotels, second home development, and hospitality. "Borscht Belt" hotels dotted the map, highways improved, and the SC International Airport became operational. The Woodstock Festival, Bethel's claim to fame, put the town on the map in 1969. With growing air travel and varied vacation options available, the number of resorts diminished, however second homes and seasonal visitors kept the Catskills alive.

Bethel Woods Center for the Arts opened its doors in 2006 on the original festival site and added the Museum in 2008. Further development of entertainment and gaming in the surrounding area has stimulated tourist interest.

Coinciding with Woodstock's 50th anniversary, Bethel created the 'Heritage Trail' of festival highlights and the SCVA established the countywide, continually growing, 'Dove Trail'.

Town of Bethel boasts fresh air and water, bucolic surroundings, lakes and waterway access, and park facilities. We are the answer to the desire 'to get out of the city' and an environmentally sustainable lifestyle.

Today our town promotes business, technology improvement, primary and second home development, tourism and the arts. Bethel offers everyone a warm welcome to a relaxed, country life...for a weekend, a season or a lifetime.
