Vikings mix in old and new this season

he Community Vikings used a big play offense to score over 25 points in four of their nine games in 2021.

With 13 players, including seven seniors returning for the 2022 season, Coach Chris Grooms of the Vikings is banking on the big play to account for a major part of the Community offense.

"We're looking for ball players, and we've got a good crew of them that's returning and been with me for four years," Grooms said.

"The big play is pretty much our M.O.," Grooms added. "We try to lull you asleep and hopefully we can catch one of those big plays with our skill set we've got."

While the returning players will provide the Vikings with experience at key positions, Grooms will be welcoming 22 new players to the squad, including three seniors and three juniors.

"We added quite a few players," Grooms said. "There's a lot of people that wanted to play this year. "We've got some basketball players that came and want to join that senior class."

"It should be interesting this year. We've also got a bunch of freshmen that joined us this year," Grooms added.

With the new players outnumbering the returning players, it has taken some time to formulate a practice routine.

"It's been kind of difficult because the last two years we've been used to working with 28," Grooms said. "With a little more, it's kind of hard getting them reps and moving them."

Three of the Viking returning seniors commented on the preseason work thus far and the focus of the team.

"The practices have been good," wide receiver Cole Crockett said. "We want to stay driven and just want to win and get better."

There has been a consistent goal as the team gets closer to opening its season.

"Overall, it's a team goal of making the playoffs," quarterback Dallas Grooms said. "We all want the same goal and we're all working to achieve it."

"We want to make history and be the first team at Community to go to the playoffs," Grooms added.

"We're all driven by each other's motivation to get there and I feel like we're

doing a great job," lineman Brycen Davis said.

Even with the large influx of new players, Davis said the team has quickly gotten used to each other.

"We've all become like a big brotherhood," Davis said. "We've became a big family and we've been able to get along with each other really well."

"With the group we have, it doesn't take long to get accepted," Crockett said. "Everybody's got their own little group and we all end up coming together."

The Vikings will complete the second season in the present 2-year classification cycle by competing in Class 3-A.

Community will face Region 4 opponents Giles County, Sequatchie County, Grundy County, and Cannon County with six non-region games on the schedule.

"We open up with Lewis County. That's always a tough one," Chris Grooms said. "We've also got Lookout Valley and Perry County before we start district."

The Viking opener at Lewis County is August 19.

Community will play its home opener the following Friday against Lookout Valley.
