# Overnight blaze destroys house

The Bedford County Fire Department was called to an overnight fire that destroyed a house in Rockvale early

Calls started coming in around 2:40 a.m. Friday, stating the house at 645 Fruit Valley Road, Rockvale, was on fire. Initial units arriving on the scene declared the house fully engulfed and requested tanker support from surrounding departments, initiating an "All Call" dispatch. That brought in support from Deason, Bell Buckle, Wartrace, Flat Creek, Normandy as well as units from Rutherford

County and Chapel Hill. According to the Tennessee Comptroller's website, the house owners are listed as Allen and Robin Johnson of Rockvale, but it is unknown if they are the current owners of the residence.

Firefighters remained on the scene throughout the early morning hours dousing hot spots. No injuries were reported and the house is considered a total loss.



### Tennessee saw record number of new business filings in first quarter

The Center Square

The Center Square - Tennessee had a record number of business formations and renewals in the first quarter There were 21,516 new business filings and 199,309

business firms renewed their active status by filing

annual reports, the largest totals in the 25-year history of the Quarterly Business and Economic Indicators report from the Secretary of State's Office and University of Tennessee's Boyd Center. "Tennessee's economy continues to outpace the nation's and shows no signs of slowing down," said Don Bruce, director of the Boyd Center for Business and Economic

Research. "These record-high new business filings in the state, along with strong personal income and stable unemployment rates, are yet another sign of continued economic growth in the coming months." There were 9,533 new business entities registered in

Tennessee's four largest counties of Davidson, Shelby, Knox, and Hamilton. The numbers come as Tennessee saw the highest

increase in the region in percent change in personal income at 7.8%. Florida (7.8%), Kansas (8.4%), and Iowa (10.1%) were the closest states with higher percentage increases between the fourth quarter of 2022 and first quarter of 2024, according to the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis.

Tennessee also saw a 3.5% increase in overall real gross domestic product over that time, which was even with Florida's 3.5% increase and higher than the rest of

#### When to test your home water supply

Water quality is not something people think about all that much, especially in developed nations. Though it can be easy to take water quality for granted in countries with ample regulation and sophisticated filtering systems, there are times when anyone, regardless of where they live, should take stock of the water in their homes.

#### Frequency of testing

One of the variables for individuals to consider is how long it's been since they last tested the water quality in their homes. For those who have never done so, those who have done it but can't recall precisely when or those who know it's been more than a year since the last test, then it's a good time to test the water. In fact, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency recommends annual testing for coliform bacteria, nitrates, total dissolved solids, and pH levels. The EPA notes this testing is especially important for anyone who is using a new well or has replaced or repaired pipes, pumps or the well casing.

#### What about public water supply systems?

Testing may not be necessary for individuals who get their water from public water supplies. The EPA notes that anyone who pays a water bill gets their water from a public supply system, which is responsible for monitoring and testing water and reporting the results of those tests to the appropriate agencies as well as the individuals who use the water. Homeowners and tenants who pay a water bill should receive an annual water quality report from their water supply utility, while renters can request a copy of that report from their landlords if they do not pay the bill

#### What about private water supply systems?

Individuals who receive their water from a private system, such as a household well, are responsible for conducting their own water supply testing. These tests should be conducted annually and in the aftermath of a spill or other incident that could taint the water supply.

#### Are there any special circumstances to test the water?

The EPA notes that certain situations may call for testing the water supply, even if it's provided by a public supply system. For example, the EPA recommends that expecting parents test their water supply for nitrates in the early months of a pregnancy. Testing should then be conducted again prior to bringing an infant home and once more during the first six months of the baby's life. The EPA notes nitrate tests are best conducted in spring or summer after periods of rain.

#### FARMERS MARKET

The market was good last week, the customers were out, the vendors were in good numbers with a good supply of products, and we're pretty much back to normal.

The market is Thursday afternoon, opening at 2:30 p.m., at the pavilion next to the big blue water tower at the Celebration Grounds.

#### **WEIGHTS AND MEASURES**

I get asked from time to time what a bushel of something weighs. Or if we have a chart with that information. This comes up each year.

This was a question to Dr. Annette Wszelaki, UT Extension vegetable specialist, that came up more than once last week. She shared this interesting information over the weekend.

The University of Nebraska has a publication on Weights and Measures for Horticultural Crops that provides approximate weight in pounds per bushel for many crops. I'll be happy to share the link with you. Just email me at jteaguel@utk.edu and request the link.

Additionally, the UT Center for Profitable Agriculture has a publication on Allowable Units of Retail Sale For Fruits and Vegetables I can provide that link as well .Producers retailing fruits and vegetables are expected to comply with regulations and guidelines regarding allowable methods of retail sale. For folks who don't have email, call the office at 684-5971 and I'll print you a

These regulations and guidelines are enforced by the Weights and Measures Section (WM) which is located within the Regulatory Services Division of the Tennessee Department of Agriculture. WM adopted these regulations and guidelines as part of the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Handbook 130 (H130).

The standards found in this document were established and adopted to promote uniformity of commerce across not only the State of Tennessee, but the entire United States. Our vendors at the market generally use a count or volume to sell by. This is also perfectly legal and accepted by the market standards.

Now, my question is who and how did these weights and measures and counts come up and when in history. Just being curious.

#### WHAT'S THE MARKET?

Drs. Andrew Griffith and Aaron Smith, UT Extension livestock and crop economists, shared these comments.

Feed cattle traded steady compared to last week on a live basis. Prices in the South were mainly \$178 to \$179 while dressed prices were mainly \$288 to \$290. The 5-area weighted average prices through Thursday were \$180.70 live, up \$0.29 compared to last week and \$289.81 dressed, up \$1.23 from a week ago. A year ago, prices were \$144.37 live and \$232.30 dressed.

There are no trends to report this week as most auctions were closed last week. Despite the holiday on Tuesday, it did not stop traders from jockeying around futures prices most of the week. The corn and feeder cattle dynamics are working with some bit of logic as corn prices decline then feeder cattle prices increase and


The big market shock was last week's acreage report, which had more corn acres and fewer soybean acres. This pushed corn prices drastically lower, which allowed feeder cattle futures to move higher. It is not just futures prices that are increasing but the cash price has as well. The CME feeder cattle index as of July 6th was over \$230 per hundredweight. This price represents an 800-pound steer in 12-states in the central part of the country. At the same time, one video sale in Tennessee saw 50,000-pound load lots of steers with average weights between 835 and 930 pounds bring between \$218 and \$224 per hundredweight, which meant some of the cattle exceeded \$2,000 per

On the grain side, after last week's dramatic decline, from \$5.94 to \$4.94 \(^34\), December corn futures moved mostly sideways trading between \$4.85 ½ and \$5.09 ½. The dramatic increase in corn planted acreage (94 million acres planted nationally) limits the upside in corn markets and opens the potential for further declines. National average yield and the potential for weather induced acreage losses will provide the direction. The U.S. drought monitor continues to indicate drought concerns in a large portion of the Corn Belt, however recent rain events have partially mitigated the impact on crops and the 5-7-day precipitation forecast has 1 to 5 inches of projected rainfall over a large area. If widespread rainfall is realized markets could easily move 25 to 50 cents

November soybeans started the week with additional gains based on the bullish soybean acreage estimate -83.5 million acres planted - in last Fridays June Acreage report but pulled back 50 cents on Thursday and Friday. Soybean acreage provides support for domestic prices however with Brazil's record crop dominating international markets, prices are unlikely to move substantially higher in the next few weeks.

## Temporary restrictions amended, extended at Franklin State Forest

NASHVILLE - The Tennessee Department of Agriculture's Division of Forestry (TDF) is amending and extending the temporary restrictions of Franklin State Forest located in Franklin and Marion Counties. Public motorized vehicle use will continue to be prohibited while non-motorized traffic, such as hiking, horseback riding, and mechanical bicycles will be allowed through January 4, 2024.

"Damage from motorized vehicles, especially in non-designated areas, is extensive at Franklin State Forest," State Forester David Arnold said. "We have been assessing conditions since March and have determined significant impact to erosion control, water quality, forest health, and other forms of recreation. This extension of some restrictions will provide our forest staff time to make repairs and consider future use on all forest roads and trails to adequately protect, conserve, and enhance this public forest for future generations."

Under the amended restrictions for Franklin State Forest, all motorized vehicle use including, but not limited to, motorcycles, dirt bikes, all-terrain vehicles, and off-highway vehicles is prohibited. This restriction is mandated pursuant to Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 0080-07-01-.05 for the protection of Franklin State Forest and the safety and welfare of visitors. Motorized vehicles are allowed to access the three designated parking areas on the forest.


Failure to comply with this use restriction is a violation of state law and may result in civil penalties and/ or criminal charges. This order expires on January 4, 2024, unless extended or otherwise rescinded by the State Forester.

Law enforcement with the department's Agricultural Crime Unit (ACU) have continued to patrol Franklin State Forest. One arrest was made following multiple notices of violations. ACU will continue to enforce restrictions.

Foresters are working to rehabilitate damaged roads and trails. So far, TDF staff have worked nearly 1,000 hours to repair 6 miles of roads damaged by motorized vehicles. Another 30 miles of roads and trails remain for repair and improvement.

Damage to forest resources from motorized





vehicles is not limited to Franklin State Forest. The division is monitoring and assessing measures to correct abuses across the state forest system, which includes 15 state forests totaling 168,000 acres. For all other state forests, the use of motorcycles, trail bikes, all-terrain vehicles, bicycles, and other offroad vehicles in any area of a state forest is strictly prohibited, except on

designated roads or trails maintained by TDF.

# **Poll: Tennessee residents** overwhelmingly support Trump

The Center Square -Tennessee residents support Donald Trump for president in 2024 by a wide margin, according to a new, wide-ranging poll of 1,120 Tennessee residents from Beacon Center.

Trump holds a 49 percentage-point lead over Ron DeSantis with 61% supporting Trump and 12% supporting DeSantis Republicans. amongst Trump also holds a 21 percentage-point lead over Joe Biden in the state, with 55% of the support compared to Biden's 36%.

If it were a race between Biden and DeSantis, Tennessee voters supported DeSantis with 52% of the vote and Biden with

"These primary results reflect what we've seen in national polls for months, that a rematch between Joe Biden and Donald Trump is the most likely scenario in 2024," said Beacon spokesman Mark Cunningham. "It is interesting that Trump fares substantially better against

Biden than Ron DeSantis does, and the change came almost exclusively from Republican voters who say they would vote for Trump as their nominee but would not vote at all if DeSantis were the nominee."

When asked about the decision to indict Trump, 43% approved of the move while 44% disapproved. Of those who voted for Trump in 2020, 17% approved of the decision to indict the former president while 72% disapproved.

The poll also asked Tennessee residents about

Bud Light and a recent boycott after the company used transgender woman Dylan Mulvaney for a marketing campaign.

The poll showed that 37% of the Republicans who said they used to drink the beer stopped drinking it after the campaign and only 10% of those Republicans who stopped said they would drink it again. Only 2% of Democrats said they stopped drinking Bud Light due to the marketing campaign.

## TACIR recommends adding Memphis-Nashville-Chattanooga passenger rail

Tennessee should move forward on plans to pursue a passenger rail line from Nashville to Chattanooga to Atlanta, according to a new report from the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations. The TACIR report asked

the Tennessee Department of Transportation to move forward to determine the cost and engineering of adding that rail service. TACIR was tasked at

looking into the feasibility of adding passenger rail routes in the state after Amtrak announced a 2035 plan to bring service back to Nashville. Nashville last had Amtrak service in

1979, when the Floridian running from Chicago to Miami discontinued service due to poor ridership.

The state currently has one line of Amtrak service daily on a route between Chicago and New Orleans that stops in both Memphis and Newbern-Dyersburg. In the pre-pandemic fiscal year 2019, a total of 64,401 passengers used the service. That number dropped off significantly to 34,885 in FY 2020 and then was 27,124 in FY 2021.

The TACIR report, however, said long-term expected highway congestion data shows the time it

takes to commute across the state could significantly increase in coming years. "It takes two or three Nashville to Chattanooga, Knoxville, or Memphis today," the report said. "But what if traffic added an hour to each of those trips — the equivalent of extending your drive from Nashville to Knoxville up to Greeneville — and what if that three- to four-hour trip was the new norm?"

The top TACIR recommended priorities are the Nashville to Chattanooga line and a Memphis to

Nashville line, along with a line from Chattanooga to Knoxville to Bristol. In the meantime, the

## **Former Lady Champion standout reflects** on injury-shortened season with Mocs

After going 1-for-2 at the plate in the Chattanooga Mocs' 4-3 seasonopening win over James Madison, former Cascade Lady Champion, Kailey Snell, suffered a shoulder dislocation injury that sidelined her for over a month before she returned in early March for the Madeira Beach Invitational.

Upon returning, it took some time for Snell to get back into the swing of things, but once she found her rhythm again, she performed at a level that had her on pace to record her best statistical season of her

In 16 games post-injury, Snell logged a batting average of .317 with only three strikeouts in 41 at-bats while stealing bases at a 5-for-6 clip. Her best game came against Virginia Tech on March 24 where she went 3-for-4 at the plate with two runs

Less than two weeks later Snell re-aggravated her injury against Georgia State, and due to some complications with her shoulder not going back into the socket smoothly, emergency room doctors were forced to put her under anesthesia to return it to its proper place.

She then had to have shoulder reconstruction surgery on April 20 to increase stabilization in her shoulder and prevent any further injuries and her junior campaign came to a close.

"For me personally, being sidelined for this lengthy amount of time was not easy. I wish that I could say that this time in my life was easy, but going from playing to not, then back to playing, then eventually being done for the remainder of the season was an emotional roller coaster, to say the least," Snell said.

"I just had to remind myself that all I could do for my team was work on getting better. My team was behind me every step of the way, which I am so thankful for."

Just a year ago, the sky was falling in Cincinnati with a paltry effort that landed the Reds a 100-loss season.

The front office had moved virtually all the talent to other teams and simply wouldn't invest in the club.

After clearing out many big names, aside from 19-year veteran Joey Votto, and losing 100 games, there wasn't much faith in this club being a competitive player in the NL Central, let alone making a run at the division lead.



Cincinnati rookie phenom Elly De La Cruz (44) has been arguably the most electric baseball player in all of the MLB since being called up in June and has firmly planted himself in the Rookie of the Year conversation.

But as of Sunday, the Reds have a onegame lead over the Milwaukee Brewers and have won an astounding 50 games.

Since mid-May, the front office has steadily called up young talent and the youth movement in Cincinnati has been highlighted by the electric Rookie of the Year candidate Elly de la Cruz.

Just two weeks after being called up, De la Cruz hit for the cycle and firmly established himself as arguably the most electric rookie in Reds' history.

At virtually every turn, he's making history, including being the first Red in over 100 years to steal every base in an inning.

He's got a club best .325 ERA and has been nothing short of electric on the base paths.

But it's not just been De La Cruz that's led the Reds to their first division lead by the All-Star Break in over a decade.

The steady leadership of 19-year veteran Joey Votto, who has been big for the Reds in key moments, coupled with the youthful influx of talent from Spencer Steer, Jake Fraley and Matt McLain has been excellent for the Reds.

Virtually every win has had a different player step to the plate at key moments.

At one point this season, Cincinnati won 12-straight games—a feat not even the great "Big Red Machine" club from the 1970s was able to accomplish.

One area of concern has been an inconsistent pitching staff, marred by lingering injuries to three different Reds starters.

Still, the Reds have been the comeback kids and have 32 comeback wins this sea-

This club will be one to watch and if they can get healthy on the mound and stabilize what's been a lackluster ERA from the pitching staff, Cincinnati could be a National League contender in October.

#### **Biggest bust- Mets**

For the past few years, Mets owner Steve Cohen hasn't been shy about his willingness to spend money in the hopes of fielding a competitive roster to male a run at the NL East division and dethrone the Braves.

What he's got in 2023 is the highest payroll in baseball and a club struggling to even find its way to the .500 mark, let alone the division lead.

The Mets have plenty of star power, but for whatever reason, the wins just haven't

From names like Fancisco Lindor, Pete Alonso and Starling Marte, the Mets should be contenders off the potential alone.

But the big three in the Mets' battery are batting a collective .235 and haven't really been much of a threat at any point this season. Like the batting order, Cohen has

poured a ton of money into the pitching staff and with names like Max Scherzer, Justin Verlander and Carlos Carrasco, the pitching just hasn't delivered this season. Scherzer has just a 7-8 overall record

and a 4.31 ERA with 87.2 innings pitched; Verlander, though battling injury at points, has a 3.60 ERA in 70 innings, while Carrasco is limping by with a 5.16 ERA. By Sunday, the Mets are 18.5 games out

of first place and are six games under .500. While not mathematically eliminated,

it's a long road for the Mets to find their way to the playoffs in a division with the Braves, Phillies and Marlins.

#### **CY Young candidates**

With still an entire half of the season to play, there are a handful of pitchers who have firmly put themselves in the Cy Young conversation for the NL and AL.

For the NL, Zac Gallen has been consistent across the board in virtually every stat kept for the Diamondbacks. He's got an 11-3 record and sits with a

3.04 ERA in 118.1 innings pitched. He also has 125 strikeouts.

Spencer Strider has also been right in the mix at the top of the NL leaderboards with nearly identical numbers.

Strider has an 11-2 record with 104.2 innings pitched, but has struck out a staggering 166 batters to go along with a 3.44 ERA.

These two will continue to battle for the mantle of the NL's top pitching honor.

On the American League side, Shane McClanahan has led Tampa Bay, who leads the AL East, with an 11-1 record and a 2.53 ERA in 96 innings pitched.

Nathan Eovaldi has been a key component for the Texas Rangers' resurgence and has a 2.83 ERA with a 10-3 record.

No matter how the second half shakes out, all four of these pitchers will have a say in the Cy Young voting.

#### **MVP** candidates

By the 2023 All-Star Break, it really seems clear-cut who the AL and NL MVP front runners are.

Since his MLB debut in 2018, there's not really been a comparable player to Shohei Ohtani—the man can literally do As virtually the MLB's only two-way

player, Ohtani has been at the top of the AL stats, both at the plate and on the mound. On the mound, Ohtani is 7-4 with a 3.32

home runs and 55 RBIs that has led an excellent Braves roster. Acuna has consistently been a hot commodity for the Braves' roster, but his 2023

campaign is by far his best of his career so far. He's already got 79 runs scored and 41 stolen bases, four-better than his 37 swiped

bags in all of the 2019 season. As long as these two frontrunners avoid injury, the MVP awards are theirs for the taking.

#### Rookie of the Year

Corbin Carroll has been the hottest name in the Rookie of the Year conversation—that is until Elly De La Cruz was called up by Cincinnati.

Carroll has been stellar for the firstplace Diamondbacks with 18 home runs, 48 RBIs and a .289 batting average.

But like Carroll, De La Cruz has planted himself in the Rookie of the Year conversation and his club is in first place of its division—it's really no coincidence.

While Carroll does have a bigger sample size, having played in 86 games, De La Cruz has been arguably more dynamic.

De La Cruz has appeared in just 30 games, but in his second week in the MLB, he hit for the cycle in just six innings against Atlanta, has a .325 batting average with nine doubles, two triples, four home runs and 16 RBIs.

He's also stolen 16 bases as well, including becoming the first Cincinnati player in over 100 years to steal all four bases in one inning.

It's no secret De La Cruz has been a key piece of the Cincinnati turnaround, who sits with a one-game lead for control of the NL Central over the Brewers.

The thing about picking Rookies of the Year is trying to gauge the effectiveness over a bigger sample size.

While Carroll certainly has a more experience, it's clear De La Cruz was the top prospect in all of baseball for a reason and should help not only give the Rookie of the Year race an exciting finish, but also impact the NL Central and shakeout of the NL playoffs come October.






#### Poll: Tennessee residents support expanding K-12 ESA voucher program

The Center Square Tennessee residents support expanding the state's educational savings account program to the rest of the state, according to a new wide-ranging poll from Beacon Center.

The ESA expansion

support is at 69% who strongly or somewhat support the idea while 13% oppose it and 16% are not sure, according to the 1,120 people polled. The Tennessee

Legislature approved addpilot program this spring and Gov. Bill Lee signed

ing Hamilton County to the

year will be the second for the ESA program, which was passed in 2019 and then blocked in court until the summer of 2022. The program allows for 7,500 in the second year before growing to 10,000, then 12,500 and 15,000 students in the fifth year. The first ESAs were estimated to be worth

\$7,572 in the first year and then have grown to \$8,684. Families must have an

annual household income that does not exceed twice the federal income eligibility guidelines for free lunch to be eligible. They also must attend a school

district with at least three schools identified as a pri-

ority school in 2015 and 2018 and must have been among the bottom 10% of schools as identified by the Department of Education in 2017.

Beacon Center's poll showed that 75% of Republicans support the expansion, 61% of Democrats support it, and 71% of those who identify as independent support it. The poll showed 28% of Democrats exposed the expansion. Support for expanding

ESAs also went across all three of the state's grand divisions with 67% support in East Tennessee, 70% in Middle Tennessee, and 73% in West Tennessee.

Overall, only 36% of voters are satisfied with Tennessee's K-12 public education. The poll showed that 56% are unsatisfied with the current system.
