Mustang golfers finish third

Eldon's golf Mustangs brought home the program's fifth state trophy, finishing in the MSHSAA Class 3 Golf Championships May 15-16, at Meadowlake Acres Country Club in New Bloomfield.

Conditions were less than ideal, both days on the Par 72 course. Still, the Mustangs fired a team score of 325 in Monday's first round, to put them in fourth. On Tuesday, the Mustangs shot a 319 to finish with a 644.

On Monday, Teagen Hull fired a 77. Luke Barchenski carded a 79. Brody Rader had an 84. Zach Hull shot an 85 and Talon Hull had a 92.

"The boys didn't have the best day one, Eldon coach Matt Frey said. "But (they) went right back to the course and headed to the range to make some adjustments for day two."

Day two saw a lot of improved play. Talon Hull, improved by 14 strokes, finishing with a 78 to finish with a 170, good enough to place in a tie of 38th out of 87 golfers in the field.

Rader also improved his core. He working on a really nice round until trouble on his final hole left him with an 82 for a two-day score of 166, tied for 26th.

Zach Hull shot an 88 on Tuesday to finish with a two day total of 173 to finish in a tie for 46.

Barchenski, possibly the steadiest player on the squad, fared no better, but no worse. He added another 79 to his total, giving him a 158 and a tie for 14th place. Teagen Hull, fied an 80 on Tuesday. His two-day score of 157 was good enough for 13th place.

"I didn't play my best either day," Hull said. "I'll take a little break, then get ready for the summer."

The Mustangs were in a dual with rival Blair Oaks for thirrd and fourth postions throughout much of the day. The two teams exchanged positions several times as the golfers were wrapping up the tournament.

Teagen Hull and Barchenski, both juniors earned individual medals and all-stat honors based upon their finishes in the tournament.

Despite the season not ending how the players wanted it, Frey said he was very pleased with how his young team fared.

"To say I am proud of the boys' season is an understatement," Frey said.

Frey felt his team, consisting of two juniors and three freshmen, had a chance to be a threat all year long.

"Before the season, I knew this team would be able to do something great," he said.

"The boys have proven they are one of the top teams in the state week in and week out. Winning all of our tournaments, conference and district made them believers. I knew coming into the state tournament and having a young team was gonna have its hiccups.

They were able to have a better day two and move into third place as a team. I think all of the accomplishments from the season has set the team up for a strong future for the program. Mustang golf is here to stay."

Bishop LeBlond won the team title with a 622. Logan-Rogersville finished with a 632, followed by Eldon's 644 then Blair Oaks with a 647.

Other team scores were: Barstow 668. Hallsville 676, Dexter 682 and St. James 705.

Individually, Bishop LeBlond's Timothy Johnston won the event with a 145, two strokes better than runner-up, Jaxon Bailey of Monett. Blair Oaks' Dylan Bryan and Hallsville's Logan Cox tied for third with a 148.

Mustang golfers win Versailles Invitational

Eldon's young golf squad captured its first tournament title of the season Wednesday, April 5, outlasting 14 other teams to win the Versailles Invitational at Rolling Hills.

Using the modified Stableford scoring system, which awards a point value depending upon how a player finishes a hole, the higher the score, the better.

Eldon finished with a team score of 259. Blair Oaks was next with 248 and Cole Camp with 236. Iberia finished ninth with a team score of 103.

Individually, Teagen Hull led the Mustangs with a 58, good enough to tie for first place. Other Mustang medalists were Brody Rader, fourth (56) and Luke Barchenski eighth (54).

Other scores for Eldon were: Zach Hull 46, Talon Hull 45 and Mason Dierking 27.

For Iberia, Trenton Alexander had the best score. He placed 28th overall with 32 points. Noah Fancher finished in a tie for 31st with 29 points.

Other scores for the Rngers were: Jake James 21. Isaac Parker 12 and Ross Pemberton eight.

Eldon wins district title

All five qualify for state tournament

Eldon's outstanding golf season will continue as the Mustangs won the MSHSAA Class 3, District 3 Tournament Monday, May 8, at Cassville Golf Club.

Mustangs saw all five team members qualify for the state tournament as they finished the day with an overall team score of 309, finishing six strokes ahead of Logan-Rogersville.

Only the top two teams plus top 12 individuals (and ties) not on qualifying teams advance to the state tournament.

Individually, Eldon dominated the top 10, as the Mustangs had four players finish among the top 10 out of 76 players in the field.

Teagen Hull fired an even par 72 to share individual medalist honors with Monett's Jaxon Bailey.

Zach Hull finished fifth with a 77. Talon Hull finished sixth with a 78 and Luke Barchenski finished in a tie for ninth with an 82. Brody Rader finished in a tie for 20th with an 86, sneaking into the final slot.

Out of the other teams earning spots at state, the Mustangs' 309 was second, only to Bishop LeBlond's 301.

The Mustangs will compete in the MSHSAA Class 3 Golf Championships May 15-16, at Meadowlake Acres Golf Club, located in New Bloomfield.

The Mustang golfers should be familiar with the course, as several have played the course as part of the Missouri Junior Tour. Tee times will be released later this week.

Eldon's Golf Mustangs dominated the field on their way to a win in the Tri-County Conference Golf Tournament Tuesday, April 25, at Eldon Golf Club.

The Mustangs fired a team score of 307, which is their third-best 18-hole score of the season, as they won comfortably over Blair Oaks.

Eldon squad sets school 18-hole record

Eldon's golf Mustangs set a new 18-hole record Thursday, April 6, as they won the Boonville Masters Tournament at Hail Ridge Golf Club. It was the second tournament victory for the Mustangs in as many days.

Eldon fired a team score of 301 to record the lowest 18-hole score in the program's history.

Three Mustangs earned medalist honors in the event.

Five finished among the top 15 placers while all six players who took part shot less than 100.

Junior Teagen Hull fired a 72 to finish second to Tolton's Andrew Fallos. Fellow junior Luke Barchenski was third with a 73. Zach Hull finished tied for eighth with a 77.

Talon Hull carded a 79 and finished in 12th, he missed medalist honors by one stroke. Brody Rader finished in a tie for 13th place, shooting an 80.

Eldon's sixth player, Mason Dierking, fired a 99. Zach Hull, Talon Hull, Rader and Dierking are all freshmen.

Eldon's 301 was 10 strokes better than Tolton (311). Blair Oaks shot a 318 to finish third, followed by So. Boone (319) and Salisbury (338)

Boonville finished sixth with a 345 and Osage finished ninth with a 352.
