



WHAT TO HAVE ONBOARD

When preparing to go out on a vessel, there are a few things you need to check that are legally required to be on board. The Missouri State Highway Patrol, Water Patrol Division advises operators to make sure these items are handy.

PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES

Under federal law, a wearable PFD is required for each person on board regardless of vessel length. Children under the age of 7 must wear a U.S. Coast Guard-approved PFD



at all times unless the child is confined to a totally enclosed area such as a houseboat or a day-cruiser.

NAVIGATION LIGHTS

The required navigation lights differ depending on the size and type of your vessel. You must display the required navigation lights between sunset and sunrise and during periods of restricted visibility.



FIRE EXTINGUISHER

All vessels (there are few restrictions) are required to have a Type B, U.S. Coast Guard-approved fire extinguisher on board in an accessible area. Check the charge level of your fire extinguishers regularly. Replace them immediately if they are not fully charged.

SOUND PRODUCING DEVICES

Vessels more than 16 feet but less than 40 feet in length are required to carry a whistle or horn to signal intentions or positions. Vessels that are 40 feet or more in length are required to carry a whistle or horn and a bell on board.

The Fishing Report

Your guide to catching fish at LOZ!

The lake level was 658.9, generation of 1,000 CFS (cubic feet per second) at the beginning of the week increasing to 4,000 CFS by the end of the week for a level of 658.6 by the weekend. Surface temperature at Bagnell Dam was 85 degrees. Truman Lake was at the 704.4 level. To Note

The Lower Lake is from the dam to the 22-mile mark; Mid-Lake is from the 22- to 44-mile mark, the Upper Osage is from the 44-mile mark to the Route 65 Bridge.

Bagnell Dam spillway/Osage River

Water clarity: Stained. Catfish: Fair on bait shrimp.

Lower Lake

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Fair on drop shot worms on main lake points. Crappie: Fair on jigs and minnows along main lake docks 20 to 25 feet deep. White bass: Good on topwater lures and inline spinners when the fish are surfacing on the main channel.

Gravois

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Fair on Texas-rigged plastic worms or creature baits and jigs 25 to 30 feet deep around brush early and late in the day or at night. Crappie: Fair trolling crankbaits.

Mid-Lake

Water clarity: Stained. Black bass: Fair on Texas-rigged 10-inch plastic worms 8 feet deep around docks. Crappie: Good on jigs or minnows 14 to 15 feet deep around main lake docks. Catfish: Fair drifting cut sunfish in the backs of coves.

Grand Glaize

Water clarity: Stained. Black bass: Fair on Texas-rigged creature baits and plastic worms 6 to 15 feet deep around brush in main lake pockets. Crappie: Fair on jigs 18 feet deep over brush or around main lake docks for fish suspended 15 to 20 feet deep.

Niangua

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Slow on Texas-rigged plastic worms or creature baits, crankbaits and spinnerbaits along main and secondary points. Crappie: Fair on minnows or jigs 15 to 25 feet deep around docks. Catfish: Good on cut baits around docks.



Upper Osage

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Fair on Texas-rigged and shaky head plastic worms around docks and brush 8 to 10 feet deep on the main channel. Crappie: Fair on minnows 15 feet deep around docks. White bass: Fair on jigs, Roostertails, plastic grubs and spoons along points in the mornings and evenings or during periods of current. Catfish: Good on float lines baited with cut shad or tight-lining off docks with nightcrawlers and prepared baits.

Truman Dam spillway

Water clarity: Clear. Fishing is slow for all species.



Top 5 ways to enjoy fall boating



hile the cooler temperatures may keep you from jumping in the water, boating is still one of the best ways to enjoy the beauty of the Lake. Calmer water, smaller crowds and fun events are just a few of the reasons we love fall boating.

1 Scenic Sunsets

Days are shorter in the fall and sunsets are the most scenic ways to end the day. Head out early enough to get a good spot in a cove by boat or just cruise down the main channel. The views are impressive.

Expect sunsets to be between 7:10-7:30 p.m. this time of year at Lake of the Ozarks, getting earlier and earlier by the minute with each passing day.

If you can't go by boat, some Lake area restaurants have amazing views. Baxter's Lakeside Grill and JB Hook's are among the most popular for catching the sunset. You could also take a cruise on board the Celebration or Tropic Island excursion yachts.



A hands-on adventure

Sunrise Beach Safari opens petting zoo

nteract with some exotic animals for a unique hands-on experience at a new petting zoo on the Lake's west side. Tonia Haddix and Jerry Aswegan recently opened Sunrise Beach Safari after spending more than 30 years operating a mobile petting zoo outside of the area. Tonia brokers exotic animals. They moved to the Lake area about two years ago.

"We both decided we needed to do a stationary petting safari so we could share our love for animals with people," Tonia said.

They've started with a "quant little safari" with the comfort of the animals in mind. There are 25 various critters to see, including the opportunity to have a few personal encounters. The star of the show is often Noah, the resident camel, but the zoo includes a wallaby, kangaroo, exotic hood stock, and many other creatures.

"Our goal is to share our love of the animals with folks and for them to get to interact with them up-close and personal," Tonia said. "For the love of our animals, and to educate people on respect and responsible private ownership."

While the property is 28 acres, they are planning on building the safari in stages. For now, they are on a "trial run." By next spring, they expect to have twice as many animals on the property.

Admission is \$15 for adults, \$10 for children ages 4-11, and free for children 3 and under. Feed cups are \$5, pony rides are \$10, sloth encounters are \$50 for adults and \$25 for children (second animal encounter half-price).

Tonia encourages visitors to build a relationship with the animals, and come back to visit them often.

Longtime "dive bar" elevates food

hen Ilene Vanabbema decided to open up a waterfront bar on the Gravois Arm, she wasn't quite prepared for the challenges that would soon follow. Like many Lakefront establishments, finding seasonal employees on the heels of a pandemic proved to be a difficult.

No stranger to the restaurant business, llene has owned Maggie's Bar & Grille in downtown Boonville for more than 15 years. Named after a formerly-beloved pet, the popular restaurant is a local hangout in the style of an old English pub. Once the pandemic hit and things began to slow down, llene found herself spending more time at her old log home in Gravois Mills. A patron of the old Frog's Bar & Grill, Ilene said when it was placed on the market in 2020 she decided to take it over. After 25 years of being known as "Frog's" the restaurant reopened with a new name, a new look, and a new menu.

Due to the difficulty of finding employees, the restaurant was only open four days a week the first year in business. With fingers crossed, llene brought in more help this season and has not only been able to stay open six days a week but has expanded the menu. At first it consisted of mainly fried foods and pizza, but this year many homemade items and some locally-sourced ingredients are crafting dishes that leave patrons craving more. The 7-ounce Missouri Angus beef are hand-pattied into 7-ounce burgers which have become as well-known at the Lake as they are at the Boonville location. Another popular item are the hand-breaded Wisconsin cheese curds,

homemade fried pickles and the Homemade Chicken Bites.

Pizza comes in thin, extra think or a gluten-free cauliflower crust. Salads, baskets and a variety of burgers and sandwiches make up the remainder of the menu.

Warm Hospitality & Entertainment

Ilene doesn't mind being busy. It's a place that thrives on camaraderie so she'll often stop to check on a table or help the bartender sling a few drinks. There's not an aspect of the business she doesn't handle daily — from running to the supply room or stepping into the kitchen to help during the dinner rush.

"I'm a social person," she says. "I like the stress when it's busy."

The bar's interior pays homage to its past with vintage photographs, signs and articles explaining the history of the area.

Table games such as Brain Teaser and

Connect Four, cornhole on the outdoor patio, songs on the jukebox, and friendly staff keep the atmosphere fun and playful.

Those seeking refuge from the summer sun will find it without having to give up being outdoors. The additional dock space provides ample parking for boaters and the amount of outdoor seating allows everyone to have a view of the Lake while enjoying their meal. The indoor dining room is easily converted to outdoor space by opening up the garage doors leading to the patio.


Locals gather on weekdays, especially for the scheduled entertainment and Monday night bingo from 6-8 p.m. Ilene shops specifically for the prizes awarded to bingo winners and admits some of them might be a little unusual. Live music is regularly held on Saturdays.
