

# The Fishing Report

## Your guide to catching fish at LOZ!

### Bagnell Dam Report

The lake level was 659.7, generation of 32,000 CFS (cubic feet per second) decreasing to 23,000 CFS throughout the week for a lake level of 659.1 by the weekend. Surface temperature at Bagnell Dam was 74 degrees. Truman Lake was at the 711.2 level. To Note: The Lower Lake is from the dam to the 22-mile mark; Mid-Lake is from the 22- to 44-mile mark, the Upper Osage is from the 44-mile mark to the Route 65 Bridge.

### Tournament Results

No tournaments were reported last weekend.

### Bagnell Dam spillway/Osage River

Water clarity: Murky. Black bass: Fair on jigs around shallow wood. Crappie: Fair on small swimbaits around current breaks. White bass: Good on Roostertails and small swimbaits around eddies. Catfish: Excellent on cut shad and skipjack herring.

### Lower Lake

Water clarity: Murky. Black bass: Good on jigs, finesse worms on drop shot rigs, crankbaits and Texas-rigged plastic worms along main lake points. Crappie: Fair trolling crankbaits in the middle of coves.

### Gravois

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Good on Whopper Poppers and Flukes along main and secondary points. Crappie: Fair trolling crankbaits in the middle of coves.

### Mid-Lake

Water clarity: Murky. Black bass: Good on shaky head worms, creature baits and crankbaits along main lake points and bluff ends. Crappie: Good on jigs along main channel docks and bluff edges. White bass: Good on jigs along main lake docks.

### Grand Glaize

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Excellent on crankbaits, jigs, Texas-rigged plastic worms and spinnerbaits on main lake and secondary points. Crappie: Fair on jigs 8 to 15 feet deep around brush piles.

### Niangua

Water clarity: Muddy. Black bass: Fair on jigs, shaky head worms and crankbaits along chunk rock banks. Crappie: Fair shooting jigs under main lake docks. Cat-



fish: Fair on jug lines with shad sides, sunfish and beef spleens.

### Upper Osage

Kids aged 7 to fifteen compete regionally to come to Augusta National for the finals each year. **T**he Lake of the Ozarks is a navigable water way that is regulated by the United States Coast Guard. This includes any commercial businesses that involve water transportation, charter work, boat towing, fishing guiding, tour site-seeing trips, pushing barges, boat delivery, and more. It is a federal regulation that the operator of these vessels must be a credentialed USCG Captain.

The State of Missouri is home to 100 lakes and 256 rivers. many of these are considered navigable waterways and fall under these regulations, requiring a captain's credentials.

Captain's credentials can and do open many opportunities to incorporate the love of boating and operating a business.

## CAPTAIN JOSHUA GOULD

Captain Gould is a St. Louis native and has been spending time at the Lake since he was a child. He is a business owner in St. Louis and the president of Gould Holdings which specializes in luxury Airbnb's, event spaces, and commercial and residential design work. He is a avid art collector, architecture enthusiast, and designer. He enjoys quality time with his family and friends, as well as dinners out, and copious amounts of travel and taking in different cultures.

Captain Gould became a licensed captain three years ago. He recalls coming to the Lake as a child and his dad teaching him to operate a boat. He immediately fell in love with the water and even has a tattoo that says "at home on the water" which reflects that.

During his teenage years he and his dad did not make it to the lake as often. He missed it and for his 25th birthday bought himself a 340 Sundancer cruiser vessel. 

"They mentioned that they would like to get out on the water but the cost was too much and their group was too large for a rental boat." On the way back home, Mini suggested starting a water taxi. "No one had ever done that at the Lake before," he said.

Having previous business experience, he spent the next few months researching how to obtain a captain's license and get the business going. By early summer in 2011 they were up and running.

When asked what he likes best about what he does, Captain Bascue replied, "The best part of this business is being a part of a special event in someone's life. We carry more than 500 passengers every week on our fun cruises, water taxis, corporate and family charters and shuttles. A large part of passengers are celebrating a special event in their life, bachelor and bachelorette parties, birthdays and employee appreciation events. We get to be a part of that."

Captain Bascue added, "Many of these folks have never been to the Lake of the Ozarks before and they have entrusted us to help make their time here memorable. Carrying this many people, we also have a positive impact on supporting our community and the waterfront bar and grills in the area we serve. ## CAPTAIN BOB MAY

Captain May was born and raised in Kansas City. He attended NW Missouri State University and also served three years in the US Army with one tour in Vietnam.

In 1974 he married his wife and band member Maureen. They played together in a band called the rock band "Festival" for three years. Maureen then got her first music teaching position and May his first job in radio.

Soon after being married they attended a wedding at the Lake. They rented a boat and two week later owned a boat of their own. Over the years they owned various vessels and took many boating courses, including the US Coast Guard eight weekend class. In 2012 May took the OUPV Captain's Course and two years later upgraded to the 50-Ton Master.

Captain May joined the Water Safety Council in its second year of operation and he and Captain Beck formed the Lake of the Ozarks Captain's Association. He is also a trainer for the Freedom Boat Club.

Captain May is a Certified National Safe Boating Council trainer and helped to form Lake of the Ozarks Boat Safety Training. In May of 2007, Bob's No Wake Zone website came to life, and in 2011 the radio show Bob's No Wake Zone Boating Show began airing.

"Now it's 13 years later and I've completed and aired nearly 700 one-hour shows featuring over 2500 guests covering all kinds of boating topics," he explained. "There's a lot of boating and water safety information, new products, technology, basics and commonsense topics.

The show began on KKD FM in Clinton and then moved to KRMS AM in Osage Beach. "Mo and I had always planned to live here, but this

helped with that transition," he said. "People ask what I'm going to talk about on my winter shows. There's boating safety, boat shows, projects that the Water Safety Council has underway, and urging people to wear their life jackets and hire a Licensed USCG Captain if they plan on drinking while boating."

## CAPTAIN DOUG BECK

Captain Beck has been boating since the age of 14. He originally boated in Iowa and Minnesota with a Sears 14ft semi-V boat powered by a one-half horsepower outboard. From there his boats continued to increase in size. He moved to the Lake of the Ozarks area in 2001.

In 2002 he completed a US Coast Guard class through World-wide Marine to earn his OUPV (Operator of Uninspected Passenger Vessels) and vessel assist USCG License. The following year he upgraded to a 25-ton grade Master. Captain Beck currently holds a 100 -Ton Master.

Captain Beck provides charter work and operates boats for water taxi, Celebration, Tow Boat US, The Lake Hopper and Playin' Hooky. He offers boating operating lessons through Freedom Boat Club and is a certified instructor by the National Safe Boating Council.

In 2017, Captain Beck and Captain Doug May founded the Captains Association of the Lake of the Ozarks. The association grew in membership to include captains that operated in all of the major Missouri water ways. Today it is known as the Captain Association of Missouri. It is a professional not-for-profit organization for coast guard licensed captains who operate primarily on Missouri waterways and serve the maritime public.

Captain's Association of Missouri seeks to promote safety, education and good fellowship between operators and The Lake of the Ozarks Water Safety Council, the United States Coast Guard, and the Missouri State Highway Patrol Water Patrol Division.

Currently the association has over 100 members. The membership dues are returned to the community in the form of scholarships, donations to hurricane victims, boater education seminars and more.

It also provides the "hire a captain" service in which individuals can request captain services, group charters, boating lessons, boat delivery, fishing guides and other water transportation needs.

A result of the Captains Association's services, Captain Beck has provided captains service for the television series "Beyond Oak Island" search for a sunken steamboat near Boonville, Missouri. He supplied boats for film crew, the director and cast of "Curse of Oak Island." He also starred in a production of the Discovery Channel Kids and Outdoors in which he taught a young person how to operate a boat, boating ethics and enjoyment of boating life.

"The captain's credentials has opened a world of enjoyment and opportunities," he said. "As they say, it is not work if you get to do what you love."

The historic Willmore Lodge has a large exhibit dedicated to the history of the Bagnell Dam Project. The Adirondack-style Lodge was built in 1930 as the main administrative offices and entertainment facility for Union Electric's Bagnell Dam construction project.

Today, the two-story log structure is home to the Lake Area Chamber of Commerce and is a cultural activities center, but it also houses a museum. The museum highlights an exhibit about life in the area before the Dam (including an exhibit about the Osage Indians), a room presenting information about the construction of the Dam from start to finish, an area dedicated to the form and function of Bagnell Dam, and an exhibit concerning the geography, geology, overall history of the Lake.

Make sure to take a walk down to the gazebo by the Lake. Great views and a peaceful spot to take photos.

# One Delicious Plate at a Time

**F**oods that feed the eye and satisfy the palate are what diners expect from fine dining. After ordering, there's time for conversation before those plates of food arrive, and quite often, people linger after their last bite. All of that and more is what Wok-N-Roll delivers, one delicious plate at a time.

In 2007, when owner and chef Nok Knernschield opened Wok-N-Roll, it was almost a one-woman show. Nok greeted customers, took orders, cooked and served food, then cleaned everything in a tiny space on Bagnell Dam Boulevard. In the intervening 15 years, the restaurant has grown to offer more seating under soft lights glowing against vibrant walls. The kitchen is much larger for better workflow, but Nok still greets newcomers and long-time customers, tosses fresh ingredients into seasoned woks, and monitors the flames as she brings Pad Thai and spicy curries to life.

Nok began learning about flavor and kitchens in the family home in Thailand so cooking was a natural career path when she grew old enough to help support her siblings. Working in restaurants, Nok expanded her palate and skills. She learned about Korean and Indian flavorings and she liked them all. That's why Wok-N-Roll's daily specials have international flair.

However, Wok-N-Roll consistently offers menu items customers love. One of them is Nok's Fried Rice, the restaurant's signature dish and a variation on traditional fried rice. Nok's is a mountain of golden rice with translucent onion pieces, bright red and green peppers and a touch of spice under a cilantro garnish. Most important, it is delicious as are Nok's Thai Dumplings, another tasty appetizer thanks to Nok's special talents.

Determined to offer good nutrition and complex flavors, Nok blends grains of brown rice for menu items such as Ma-saman Curry. Customers can still request white rice or a single brown rice grain if they prefer. In fact, customers can make special requests, and if the ingredients are on-hand and time is available, Nok will deliver on that request. At all times, customers can choose from vegetarian, GMO-free and gluten-free options.

Most customers trust Nok's tastes and choices. They have been supporting her restaurant since it opened, and as Nok says, people know quality in ingredients and flavors.

Nok Knernschield gives credit for her success to her Thai family who initiated her training, but that family has expanded to include the greater Lake community in which Nok has great confidence in spite of challenging days behind and ahead. Nok believes in the Lake's magnetism. Even as some prices rise, she thinks state residents will travel more right here at home and the Lake season will be among the best.





Nok will do what she can to make sure the future is bright for Lake of the Ozarks. She has a long-standing habit of giving back to schools, fire departments and service projects. They are part of her extended family as is the restaurant staff. Each one pitches in as needed to paint a vibrant square or stripe on the eye-catching art wall, to wait on customers or brew another pitcher of fresh, steeped tea.

One essential team member is absent, however. Nok's dear husband, Dennis, passed in 2020. The grief was almost insurmountable, and her heart still misses the man with whom she shared more than three decades of 24/7 togetherness. Her daughter, an attorney in Virginia, helps her carry on with daily communications, but the work Nok and Dennis began in 2007 still calls, still demands and still provides. Wok-N-Roll is that business, and Nok carries on with his memory held closely in her heart. Diners are the beneficiaries. Wok-N-Roll is a great restaurant for fine dining in a casual atmosphere on the Boulevard.
