The Fishing Report

Your guide to catching fish at LOZ!

Bagnell Dam Report

The lake level was 658.3, generation of 1,000 CFS (cubic feet per second) throughout the week for a lake level of 658.3 by the weekend. Surface temperature at Bagnell Dam was 68 degrees. Truman Lake was at the 704.6 level. To note: the Lower Lake is from the dam to the 22-mile mark; Mid-Lake is from the 22- to 44-mile mark, the Upper Osage is from the 44-mile mark to the Route 65 Bridge.

Tournament Results

Bryce Rieder won the Fall Big Bass Bash last weekend with a 7.05-pound largemouth bass.

Bagnell Dam spillway/Osage River

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Good on jigs, topwater lures and swimbaits along logs, rocks and current breaks. White bass: Good on Roostertails in the current. Catfish: Excellent on cut shad and skipjack herring.

Lower Lake

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Slow on shaky head worms around brush and docks. Crappie: Fair shooting jigs under docks and trolling crankbaits. Catfish: Fair drifting cut shad and skipjack herring around shad schools.

Gravois


Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Slow on topwater lures, buzz baits, shaky head worms, drop shot rigs with finesse worms and jigs around shad schools, brush piles and docks on the main lake and backs of creeks. Crappie: Fair on jigs 8 to 12 feet deep around brush and docks. White bass: Good on topwater lures when the fish are surfacing and chasing shad on the main lake. Catfish: Good drifting cut shad and skipjack herring around shad schools.

Mid-Lake

Water clarity: Stained. Black bass: Slow on spinnerbaits, buzz baits and jigs around shallow docks in coves. Crappie: Fair on minnows over brush 18 to 25 feet deep and shooting jigs under main lake docks.

Grand Glaize

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Fair on spinnerbaits,



crankbaits and jigs around laydowns and brush piles along points. Crappie: Slow on jigs over brush 6 to 15 feet deep.

Niangua

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Slow on spinnerbaits and jigs along bluffs and halfway back in coves. Crappie: Slow on jigs over brush 20 to 22 feet deep.

Upper Osage

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Good flipping jigs and tube baits around docks and brush in coves. Crappie: Fair on minnows around docks 8 to 12 feet deep. Catfish: Good on nightcrawlers tight-lining off docks.

Truman Dam spillway

Water clarity: Clear. Crappie: Slow on jigs and minnows in the dead-water channel. White bass and hybrids: Slow on spoons in the evenings.

issouri anglers have lots of public lakes, ponds, rivers and streams to choose from. However, the state's trout waters, in particular, are limited and can get crowded. To make everyone's experience more enjoyable wherever you fish, practice the following guidelines.

Respect Your Fellow Anglers

- Know and follow Missouri's fishing regulations.
- Don't wade in front of others and allow space for backcasting.
- Give priority to disabled anglers in areas accessible to them.
- Don't throw rocks or disturb the water.
- Minimize noise-avoid loud music or yelling.
- Observe Missouri's Guidelines for Handling and Releasing Fish.

Respect Private Property

- Most of Missouri's streams run through private land, but many landowners are happy to accommodate respectful anglers.
- Safeguard landowner goodwill. Never trespass, and always ask permission before floating or wading through private property.

Respect the Environment

- Don't litter! Put bait containers, cigarette butts and fishing line, all of which can harm wildlife and degrade others' outdoor experience, into the trash.
- Use only designated trails and parking areas.
- Don't shuffle your feet in the water to stimulate fish to feed.

Protect Missouri's Sport Fisheries

Missouri's fish are healthy and free of most diseases. To ensure that they remain that way and to keep our streams free of aquatic nuisance species, please follow these guidelines:

- Do not release live or dead fish obtained from outside the state into Missouri waters. Consult an MDC fisheries biologist before stocking any fish from any source, and be aware that importation of trout into Missouri is strictly regulated.
- Thoroughly clean boots, waders, boats, trailers and fishing tackle between uses. Do not transfer mud, aquatic plants, water or fish parts from one body of water to another.
- Report any fish kills, dying or diseased fish, or water pollution to a MDC fisheries biologist, or call the department's Environmental Health Unit at 573-815-7900.



olf is a challenging game that can sometimes frustrate even the most accomplished players. No two golf courses are the same, and seasoned players know that courses play differently each time. Greens that are accommodating on Saturday might be far more difficult on Sunday, which is part of what makes the game of golf such a fun challenge.

Pace of play may not matter much when a course isn't busy. But courses tend to draw crowds come spring, summer and early fall. During the more busy times of year, the United States Golf Association offers these tips to golfers looking to improve their pace of play.

Arrive on time and ready to play

Most courses give players a tee time, which indicates when their round will begin. Confirm the tee time the day before a scheduled round and arrive at the course ready to play. The USGA® urges players to arrive at the first tee early and with their equipment in order. Don't forget to ensure you have essentials like extra balls, tees and gloves.

Play from where you're comfortable

Each tee box features separate tees for players of various skill levels. Players who want to improve their pace of play are urged to begin each hole from the tee box where they're most comfortable. Players in the same group can play from separate tees, so if need be, choose to play from the tee nearest the pin so you can make it to the

green more quickly. Resolve to spend as little time on the tee as possible without feeling as though you're rushing your tee shot.

Strategize between shots

Once you have hit off the tee, strategize how you can get to the green as you approach your ball. Planning as you walk or drive can reduce the time you'll spend strategizing between shots, which can improve your pace of play considerably.

Limit practice swings

Practice swings can help players shoot their best, but if improving pace of play is a goal, limiting practice swings to just one before each shot can help. Practice swings can even be taken while others in your group are lining up and playing their shots. Just be sure to do so quietly and out of the sight line of your fellow players.

Work with your fellow players

Follow each player's shot during your round so less time is spent finding each golfer's ball. In addition, fill each other's divots and rake bunkers together to cut time off your round.

Use the group in front of you as a marker for time

Aspiring to keep up with the group in front of you is a good way to ensure your group is moving along. If that's proving difficult, let other groups behind you play through if they are moving more quickly than you are. Similarly, if the group in front of you is moving slowly, politely ask to play through.

Line up your putts while others are putting

Read the green while your fellow group members are putting and line up your shot accordingly so you spend less time on the greens. The USGA recommends leaving clubs on the side of the putting green that is closest to the next tee to save even more time.

This is a roughly 10 percent increase from 2019, when there were around 4,000 accidental drowning deaths.

In the U.S. drowning takes an average of 3,500-4,000 lives per year. That is an average of 10 fatal drownings per day.

Drowning is the leading cause of unintentional injury related death for children ages 1-4. Drowning remains in the top 5 causes of unintentional injury related death from birth to 54 years old.

In addition to fatal drownings, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimated that in 2016 an additional 9,000+ victims were seen at U.S. Emergency Departments for a non-fatal submersion injury.

23% of child drownings happen during a family gathering near a pool.

Lack of barriers around water contribute to a majority of drowning deaths.

Learning to swim can reduce the risk of drowning by 88 percent for 1-4 year olds who take formal swim lessons.

No one is drown-proof and drowning doesn't discriminate.

Drug and alcohol use can be large contributing variables to drowning risk.

Drowning is the cause of death for most boating fatalities.

It is estimated that for every fatal drowning victim, another five to 10 victims receive hospital related care for non-fatal drowning injuries.

Drowning is fast and silent. It can happen in as little as 20-60 seconds. Drowning doesn't always look like we would expect

Tragedy that can be avoided. Eighty-six percent of drownings are because of people not wearing a lifejacket.

The lakes and rivers are not swimming pools. There are underwater obstacles, currents, as well as boat traffic that create hazards that will increase the chances of injury, and worse, death.

Wear a lifejacket so no one will mourn.






