# From combat to coming home to the Lake

At just 18 years-old, Jordan Webb chose to enlist in the Marine Corps instead of accepting one of many Division I scholarships to play college football. Prior to graduating from Camdenton High School, Webb spent three years learning tactical training and leadership instruction through the One Shepherd Tactical School of Leadership. This influenced his decision to take the military route instead of college.

Webb was born and raised in Camdenton. HIs family had a history of protecting the country. His great uncle was best friends with Harry S. Truman, and was the head of the United States Marshalls. His grandfather served in the Navy and battled at Pearl Harbor.

"While attending Camdenton High School my best friend and I went into the training program on the buddy system," he explained. "I was learning all these skills and decided instead of college I would like to give back. I was so enamored with the guys I was learning from in military that I couldn't imagine doing anything else. I learned from some of the best in the world." These instructors, Webb said, included Christopher Larsen. Larsen is currently a Research Program Analyst who currently works on Research and Development for the US Special Forces.

In September of 2000, Webb reported to boot camp at Camp Pendleton in Southern California. He then attended the school of infantry, a specialized war fighting course that taught the use of conventional warfare and weapon systems. He attached to the 1st Battalion, 4th Marines Maritime Special Purpose Force (MSPF). Here he specialized in direct action raids, ship takedown search and seizures, and gas and oil platform takedowns, and became special operations capable. "The Western Pacific was our theatre of war," he said. "This included Singapore, Aftrained with the Kenyan Commandos "

After returning from his first deployment with the MSPF Platoon, he switched over to STA (surveillance target acquisition) in Pakistan, providing support to Operation Enduring Freedom. In 2002, he voluntarily reported to Kuwait, working with Kuwaiti commandos at their camp. "We knew we were invading Iraq, and we ran the security operations in preparation for that invasion," he said. "I was part of RCT 1 -Regimental Combat Team."

Webb recalls the morning they invaded like it was yesterday. "That morning we invaded, I was standing there with General James Mattis and over 70,000 marines, waiting to invade," he recalled. "This was my regiment, and we were just one small piece of our Division. We were the front line and the very first entry into Iraq. We were waiting and General Mattis said: you're going to be tired and bloody, but you'll never be alone. You'll have angels on your shoulders." At that precise moment, Webb said, the American aircraft support flew overhead. It took three to four days to get this many soldiers in battle formation, Webb said.

rica, Kenya, and Thailand. We Prior to the invasion, they sat 200 yards from the border.

The leadership experience, camaraderie, and skills learned from serving are priceless, Webb said. What's even more priceless, he explained, is being a father to his 12 year-old daughter Lilly. "I waited my whole life to be a daddy, and she's the light of my life," he

In 2009, Webb moved back to the Lake. An avid climber, he started an outdoor climbing company but found the need wasn't a need here. For the past several years, he has worked as the sale manager at Bobcat of Lake of the Ozarks, a company that sells, rents, and services tractors, mowers, and heavy equipment. He's an avid fisherman, and coaches youth football and soccer. Giving back, he said, has always been important to him. He also serves as a Lead Combat Instructor at One Shepherd Technical School of Leadership.

"I love what I do," he said. "I am extremely blessed and fortunate. I have an amazing and supportive family, and I live in a really cool place. I've been to 33 different countries, and there's no place in the world like here at the Lake.'











### Home at last

The remains of Korean War veteran Cpl. Gerald Wilson returned to Missouri Friday.

The plane carrying his remains landed at St. Louis Lambert International Airport 74 years after Wilson was presumed missing in action.

After decades of efforts involving Wilson's family and the U.S. Army, Wilson's remains were identified in 2018. Multiple veterans' organizations, including the Patriot Guard, escorted Wilson's remains from the airport to southwest Missouri, where Wilson was from.

A procession escorted Cpl. Wilson's remains westbound along Interstate 44 across the

Some of the groups showing their respects included mul-

tiple fire departments along Interstate 44 displaying American flags.

"It's just out of pure respect and love that we do this," Anthony Rumbo, an American Legion Rider who was at the airport to help with the escort,

David Erger, a member of the Kirkwood Hog Association, did not know Wilson's family but was determined to be at the airport to show his support. He hopes others will turn out for future displays of support for service members who paid the ultimate sacrifice.

"He fought for our country, and I was glad to do it," Erger said. "It's a way of giving back to them for what they've all done."

Beach was there to honor him.

The fallen soldier's casket was personally escorted from Hawaii by E5/Sgt. Brody Patrick via Los Angeles, Lambert International Airport in St. Louis and then to Camdenton. Once Corporal Wilson's casket arrived at the funeral home, Sergeant Patrick said his mission was complete.

Sergeant Patrick said highways and overpasses between St. Louis and Camdenton were lined with individuals showing their respect for Corporal Wilson.

### Osage Beach Veterans Memorial

After several months of planning, redesigning and negotiations, it appears the Veterans Memorial in front of Osage Beach City Hall will become a reality by Veterans

The board of aldermen recently learned that the cost and scope of the project — to be located in the circle area in front of City Hall — have been modified to be within the \$152,000 budget. When the project was first bid earlier this year, the estimated cost was between \$230,000 and \$240,000 — far above the budgeted amount.

The board tabled a deci-

sion on the project and asked city officials to work with Elks Lodge #2517 and the engineer to find a way to meet the budget.

These changes to the original plan have been made:

•Reduced overall size of the memorial

Reduced total area of paversReduced total area of con-

•Changed structural design

from foundation walls to slab on grade with curbs

•Removed curved guardrail from project.

•Removed ramps from proj-

In visiting with a potential bidder, officials learned the memorial should come in at around \$150,000.

The Elks Lodge plans is to sell memorial pavers within the circle to help defray costs of the project. Theme of the memorial is "Honoring All That Have Served" and each 4-inch by 8-inch brick can be inscribed with a short message such as name of veteran, dates served, branch of service, etc.

There will be a bronze statue in the center of the memorial.
