





The Fishing Report

Your guide to catching fish at LOZ!

Bagnell Dam Report

The lake level was 658.3, generation of 1,000 CFS (cubic feet per second) throughout the week for a lake level of 658.5 by the weekend. Surface temperature at Bagnell Dam was 54 degrees. Truman Lake was at the 706.1 level. To Note: the Lower Lake is from the dam to the 22-mile mark; Mid-Lake is from the 22- to 44-mile mark, the Upper Osage is from the 44-mile mark to the Route 65 Bridge.

Tournament Results

Adam Boehle and Mark Wilson won the Winter Bass Challenge tournament last Sunday with five bass weighing 20.93 pounds.

Bagnell Dam spillway/Osage River

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Good on jigs and Wiggle Wart crankbaits along rocky banks. White bass: Good on small swimbaits in the tailrace area. Catfish: Good on cut shad and skipjack herring.

Lower Lake

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Fair on suspending stickbaits, Rat-L-Traps, Chatterbaits and Alabama rigs from the mouths to the backs of coves. Crappie: Fair shooting jigs under main lake docks.

Gravois


Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Fair on Choppos and Whopper Ploppers along main lake points. Crappie: Slow on jigs around docks and brush 12 to 15 feet deep. Catfish: Good drifting cut shad around shad schools.

Mid-Lake

Water clarity: Stained. Black bass: Fair on spinnerbaits, buzz baits, Choppos and Rk Crawler crankbaits along main lake banks. Crappie: Good shooting jigs under main lake docks and casting jigs to brush piles 20 to 25 feet deep.

Grand Glaize

Water clarity: Stained. Black bass: Fair on spinnerbaits, suspending stickbaits, jigs and Alabama rigs along main lake pockets and shallow wood. Crappie: Good on jigs in brush 10 to 15 feet deep.



Niangua

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Fair on suspending jerkbaits, crankbaits, topwater lures and jigs around docks halfway back in coves. Crappie: Fair on jigs 10 to 15 feet around docks and brush.

Upper Osage

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Fair on spinnerbaits and Chatterbaits along main channel laydowns and rock banks. Crappie: Good on minnows and jigs 10 to 15 feet deep in brush and along bluff ends. White bass: Good on Roostertails, Kastmaster spoons and Gay Blades along windy points. Catfish: Good on cut shad, worms and shrimp.

Truman Dam spillway

Water clarity: Stained. Crappie: Fair on jigs on the main channel and the dead-water channel. Walleye: Fair on small swimbaits. Catfish: Slow on cut shad.

WINTER BOATING TIPS

inter typically means the end of boating and fishing season. Some diehards, however, are always prepared to spend their wintertime on a boat. Who said there was a boating season?

Boating is a popular activity across the United States all year long. In some locations, boaters end the season as the cold weather sets in. However, even in those places people will still boat year-round. You probably shouldn't plan to do much water skiing or tubing while boating during the winter, but you can get away with it in warmer locations such as Miami and other parts of Florida.

Winter boating usually means less crowding on lakes or rivers, so areas that are too crowded for safe or enjoyable motoring or sailing in the summer are much more easily explored and enjoyed in the winter.

Winter boat sightseeing is a great way to enjoy freedom of movement and to see familiar areas in a whole new light. In fact, you might even be able to open the throttle a bit wider and enjoy some extra knots out there thanks to less company.

In Missouri at lakes such as Lake of the Ozarks or Table Rock, the water temperature in the winter ranges from 56 degrees in November to 35 degrees in February. Typically, the only areas the lake freezes over will be in the back of shallow coves. That means you can boat year-round, providing you and your boat are prepared for cold weather.

Just remember that winter boating is much different from summer boating. Safety always comes first. Consider these tips to make your outing safe and enjoyable.

SAFETY 101

Winter boating safety is a lot like warm weather boating safety: Manage your speed, keep your eyes ahead and don't fall overboard.

Life jackets

The use of life jackets is more important during winter boating than in warm weather. When the water is cold enough, you have only 10 minutes before you lose consciousness and can't help yourself stay afloat. Personal flotation devises are critical even if you're a strong swimmer in normal conditions.

Gas up before you go

With fewer boats on the water, some fuel docks may be closed or maintain shorter hours. Don't assume you can fill up at your destination for the return trip home. Use the 1/3, 1/3, 1/3 rule: 1/3 to arrive at your destination, 1/3 for the return trip, 1/3 for just in case.

Tell someone your boating plan

File a float plan with someone you trust that includes details about the trip, where you are going, when you are returning, passengers, towing or trailer vehicle, communication equipment and emergency contacts.

Charge your batteries

This is a task that can get often overlooked. Nothing could be worse than checking off all of the above tips, getting to the boat ramp or dock slip and cranking the engine only to discover the battery is dead. Batteries drain much quicker in cold weather. Keep them charged at all times with a trickle charger.

Keep a look out

Water levels are lowered to winter pool on many manmade impoundments used for flood control. Bottom hazards are exposed or nearer the surface, so the same lake you speed across during summer is much different in the winter. Designate a passenger as the lookout to keep watch for any hazards in the path of the boat.

Watch out for ice

Large chunks can lurk largely below the surface (Titanic, anyone?) and watch for ice on docks, decks, mooring lines and wires. Iced lines are harder to work and more prone to break, while icy wires can present a shock hazard.


Keep a phone with good service and/or a transponder with you

Getting stranded on the water in the summer is a drag. Being stranded out in the winter is a danger, especially as fewer marinas are operating. Remember to call *55 which is the Missouri Highway Division Water Patrol dispatch contact in the event of an emergency.

Is winter boating a safe idea? Sure, if you're a safe

boater. Can it be fun? Absolutely. Just remember that tip about not boating after the surface freezes solid.
