# PREPARE YOUR DOCK for the season



t's about that time of year. Time to uncover your boat and head out to a waterfront restaurant or for a cruise along the main channel. Before you do, it's best to take some time to go over your boat and dock to make sure that everything is in working order.

Your boat lift does a lot of work - especially at Lake of the Ozarks. With heavy boat traffic and large wakes, it's necessary to do some general maintenance to eliminate problems before they start.

Casey Osborn, partner at LOTO Lift & LOTO Marina offers advice when it comes to making sure nothing keeps you from enjoying the Lake life. Follow these tips or call a professional to come out and inspect your boat lift so you are ready to get out as soon as the weather allows.

• It's easy to forget about your boat lift but with use comes wear and tear. Some of the most common items that get worn are bushings, fasteners and dock brackets. Pneumatic free floating lifts are constantly moving whether or not your boat is on it so don't overlook a loose bolt or arm bushing. The holes will be oblong in the dock brackets making it ineffective in securing your lift. The labor involved in changing a bracket will tempt many people to make an adjustment using a different hole in the bracket, but it's important to adjust all of the arms accordingly which may also require a change in the drop chain.

Underwater tank mounts and any steel that is underwater should be routinely replaced, on average every 3-5 years. Rusty hardware can give the illusion of tightness because it is seized up and brittle.




- Before lowering that lift for the first time this season, turn the control unit handle to "raise" and let the system bubble out for a minute. This will push water and any mud, Bryozoans, aquatic animals and other debris in the tank to come out through the large hole. If you turn the handle to "lower" instead it allows air to escape through your hose and the valve control in the unit. Eventually anything light enough will try to flow through the plumbing which traps air and does not allow the lift to fully submerge.
- During the spring, there is a big difference between the air temperature and water temperature. This will cause the air in your tank to condense and allow water into the tank causing it to loose lift capacity. Boat lifts are rated for a lift capacity, not the dry weight of a vessel. When purchasing a lift account for the weight of fuel, water, gear and winter water temps. You should be filling the lift once a month during the winter and maybe a little more frequently in March and early April when the air temps and water temp vary the most.
- The cold temps will put your plumbing fittings to the test. A weak or poorly sealed pipe fitting will show its ugly head in the form of a slow, irritating leak. Hoses also lose their flexibility adding more stress to tank fittings causing failures.
- Spring levels can add a challenging variable. The Lake will typically drop six feet and can drop as much as nine feet from full pool. If the Lake is down and you back onto your lift, be cautious that just because your boat is free floating doesn't mean that lift will clear the drive. Your lift should have drop chains that will be tight to indicate the lift is down all the way. If there is slack in the chain that's a red flag, but don't worry, you can still make your dinner date with friends. If possible, raise your drives and move the boat in and out by hand. Do not engage your props or you'll have more problems than missing dinner.

Another factor to consider when the Lake is down is if your dock has changed its position. A dock will often lean when the water level changes. This can be attributed to the extra weight of the ramp. A dock mounted parallel to the shore will lean left to right in the slip and a dock mounted perpendicular will lean forward and possibly back if the front of the dock is sitting on the bottom. This can cause problems with vapor locking, or worse. Also, check for debris that is under the lift and remove anything that could hinder the system.



## Golf tips for beginners



olf courses are serene settings that allow people to enjoy the great outdoors while simultaneously engaging in the thrill of competition. Once a commitment has been made, a new set of custom fitted clubs can be a worthy investment that lets golfers take their game to the next level. Using clubs that are too small or too large can affect performance, as can other factors like grip size. Custom fitted clubs can be expensive, so beginners may want to wait until they catch the golfing bug before they make such an investment.

· Golf with a friend. The buddy system makes numerous recreational activities more fun, and golf is no exception. Beginners can ask a friend who already plays to tag along, but it also can be fun to learn the sport alongside another novice. Friends with experience may be willing to offer some tips to becoming a better player, while two beginners can share a few laughs as they navigate their way through rounds that end up well over par.

· Choose the right courses. Certain courses are more challenging than others. Par-3 courses can be perfect for beginners because they include only par 3 holes, which feature shorter distances from tee to cup and tend to be flatter and easier for novices. Par-3 courses also tend to be just nine holes, which can be ideal for beginners. When playing a traditional course, beginners can look for one with a reputation for being less challenging so they are not discouraged by their final scores.



#### **Bagnell Dam Report**

The lake level was 656.5 generation of 3,500 CFS (cubic feet per second) throughout the week for a lake level of 656.4 by the weekend. Surface temperature at Bagnell Dam was 39 degrees. Truman Lake was at the 705.6 level. To note: the Lower Lake is from the dam to the 22-mile mark; Mid-Lake is from the 22- to 44-mile mark, the Upper Osage is from the 44-mile mark to the Route 65 Bridge.

#### **Tournament Results**

No tournaments reported last weekend.

#### **Bagnell Dam spillway/Osage River**

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Fair on Alabama rigs and suspending jerkbaits along steep rock banks. Crappie: Fair on jigs around current breaks. White bass and hybrids: Fair on 3-inch swimbaits.

#### **Lower Lake**

Water clarity: Clear. Some coves are frozen. Fishing is slow for all species.

#### **Gravois**

Water clarity: Clear. Upper Gravois is frozen and lower section has ice chunks floating around. Fishing is slow.

#### **Mid-Lake**

Water clarity: Clear. Ice chunks on the main channel and some coves are frozen. Fishing is slow.

#### **Grand Glaize**

Water clarity: Stained. Frozen in some coves and main channel above Fort Leonard Wood Recreation Area. Fishing was slow due to lack of open water.

#### Niangua

Water clarity: Clear. Frozen in coves and parts of the main channel. Little Niangua is frozen.

#### **Upper Osage**

Water clarity: Clear. Main channel and coves are frozen.

#### **Truman Dam spillway**

Water clarity: Clear. Spillway and dead-water channel are frozen.



## Catch-and-keep trout season opens March 1

very year on March 1, hundreds of die-hard anglers line the banks at one of Missouri's trout parks for the opening day of catch-and-keep trout season. In years past, anglers have faced frigid winter temperatures, snow, sleet and ice, as well as sunshine and springlike weather all in the attempt of catching an elusive lunker. This Missouri tradition not only creates memories, but some of the biggest fish stories you've ever heard!

This year, Saturday, March 1, marked the opening of the catch-and-keep season that runs through Oct. 31. To participate, Missouri residents ages 16 to 64 and nonresidents age 16 and older are required to purchase a fishing permit. In addition to a fishing permit, trout anglers must also purchase a daily trout tag at the trout parks: Roaring River State Park near Cassville, Bennett Spring State Park near Lebanon and Montauk State Park near Salem.

A daily trout tag at the three state parks costs \$5 for adults and \$3 for youth 15 years of age and younger. Daily fishing permits are \$9, and the daily limit is four trout, while possession limit is eight. For more information on fishing at Missouri trout parks, visit mdc.mo.gov/fishing/species/trout/trout-parks. Anglers are encouraged to purchase their fishing permits ahead of time from any of numerous vendors throughout the state, online at mdc-web.s3licensing.com or through Missouri Department of Conservation's free MO Fishing mobile app.

Trout season in Missouri is a cooperative effort of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Division of State Parks managing the state parks and the Missouri Department of Conservation operating the hatcheries and stocking the streams with trout.

To help prevent the spread of the invasive alga didymo (commonly known as rock snot), the use of shoes, boots or waders with porous soles of felt, matted or woven fibrous material is prohibited at all trout parks, trout streams, Lake Taneycomo and buffer areas.

## Trail of Four Winds transformed at Lake of the Ozarks State Park

popular trail at Lake of the Ozarks State Park has undergone a significant transformation thanks to the hard work of a team from the National Civilian Community Corps. After five weeks of work, the NCCC team has completed major improvements to all 14 miles of the Trail of Four Winds, including rerouting a section, widening the width and height of portions of the trail and enhancing areas to create a better user experience and improved environmental impact. The team of eight were deployed in November from the NCCC Southwest Region based in Colorado. Their last day of work on the trail was Dec. 13.

The team was awarded to Osage Beach non-profit Branches for the Lake (B4TL) and the Lake of the Ozarks State Park after the agencies partnered to be considered for the program. Branches for the Lake provided assistance writing the project application and supervised the team while they were at Lake of the Ozarks. Program applicants were required to find a lodging partner to host the team at no cost. Margaritaville Lake Resort stepped forward to offer lodging for the NCCC team. The Lake of the Ozarks State Park staff were on-site with the team daily to make sure work was done safely and on time. They provided training and expertise so that the

team could gain valuable experience and professional development.

"You can't get a big project like this completed without a lot of help, and the partnership initiated by B4TL showcases how a community can benefit from working together," Guerric Good, Interpretive Resource Coordinator for the Lake of the Ozarks State Park, said. "We have a nonprofit group seeing a need and bringing ideas and energy, a private business offering housing and a federal-level program with passionate and hard-working individuals coming together to make a state park better for local, national and international visitors. I am glad we can all share these successes."

The Trail of Four Winds is a unique, multi-use trail open to hikers, bikers, walkers and horseback riders. The trail is divided into North and South loops, providing multiple stunning views of Lake of the Ozarks, outcrops, seasonal streams, ponds and woodlands. Erosion and encroaching vegetation were causing damage to the ecosystem and forcing users to go off trail along areas of the path. Other portions needed pruning, limb removal and general maintenance to make the trail more accessible.

"Due to the hard work of the NCCC team, along with daily support and supervision by state park staff, we now have a safer, more accessible and environmentally-friendly trail that will be enjoyed by residents and visitors for years to come," Charis Patires, Grant Project Administrator for Branches for the Lake, said. "This project truly highlights the power of community collaboration and demonstrates the importance of working together to create impactful change in our community. With-

out the commitment from Margaritaville Lake Resort to house this team and the dedicated State Park staff making this project a priority, none of this would have been possible."

"Fostering a shared responsibility for the wellbeing of our community is one of our core values at Margaritaville Lake Resort - Lake of the Ozarks," Michael Cost, Assistant General Manager of Margaritaville Lake Resort, said. "Having the opportunity to work together on this project with other community leaders was fantastic! We look forward to more ways we can help bring progress to the lake area."

The NCCC team removed over 4,775 pounds of vegetation, cleared more than 16.6 acres of land, completed a 0.38-mile reroute which was difficult due to the rocky terrain, removed 6,000 pounds of rocks and improved more than 14 miles of existing trail. The estimated value of volunteer time for the 2,197 hours served on this project is worth more than \$67,000.

In addition to working on the trail throughout the week, the NCCC team volunteered with the Dogwood Animal Shelter each Saturday during their stay. They worked on building kennels at the animal shelter and sorting through donations at the thrift store. An important component of NCCC service is positive community engagement and volunteering in the communities they are deployed.

Several sponsors stepped up to support the project by donating meals, supplies and hosted outings in the community to help make the team's stay more enjoyable and to thank them for the work they were completing.

About Branches for the Lake:

Branches for the Lake (B4TL) is a non-profit based in Osage Beach dedicated to fostering economic growth through community, collaboration, connectivity and commerce. The organization has been connecting with local leaders and community partners to assess critical needs and to find solutions to challenging community problems. B4TL looks for ways to utilize paid tax dollars and invest these funds back into the community by way of grant funding and other program opportunities.
