



WHAT TO HAVE ONBOARD

When preparing to go out on a vessel, there are a few things you need to check that are legally required to be on board. The Missouri State Highway Patrol, Water Patrol Division advises operators to make sure these items are handy.

PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES

Under federal law, a wearable PFD is required for each person on board regardless of vessel length. Children under the age of 7 must wear a U.S. Coast Guard-approved PFD



at all times unless the child is confined to a totally enclosed area such as a houseboat or a day-cruiser.

NAVIGATION LIGHTS

The required navigation lights differ depending on the size and type of your vessel. You must display the required navigation lights between sunset and sunrise and during periods of restricted visibility.



FIRE EXTINGUISHER

All vessels (there are few restrictions) are required to have a Type B, U.S. Coast Guard-approved fire extinguisher on board in an accessible area. Check the charge level of your fire extinguishers regularly. Replace them immediately if they are not fully charged.





SOUND PRODUCING DEVICES

Vessels more than 16 feet but less than 40 feet in length are required to carry a whistle or horn to signal intentions or positions. Vessels that are 40 feet or more in length are required to carry a whistle or horn and a bell on board.



Clown Golf Classic to be held in April under new leadership

McIntosh who originally built the Floating Clown and then sold it to the Eblings in 1974. The Eblings were avid golfers, so in 1984 they decided it might be fun to host a golf tournament with all their friends during the off-season to raise some money for a local charity. Keeping the money local was important to them, Susan said. As former educators, the Eblings wanted to choose a local charity that would benefit children in the Lake area and over the years the tournament raised more than \$1.1 million for The Lake of the Ozarks Dream Factory. Funds will continue to support the local chapter to grant wishes to critically and chronically ill children in the Lake area. Money raised will also support other worthy causes including the Branches for the Lake Mentorship Program.

"We are honored to continue this tradition and contribute to the betterment of our community," Amy Hernandez, Director of Projects for Branches for the Lake, said. "We appreciate the assistance of event organizers for their tireless efforts in raising funds for important community needs. Their dedication has created a strong foundation for this event, and we are grateful for their assistance in making this transition seamless."

BOATING

Are you responsible with your **boat wake?**



issouri waterways have become increasingly busy over the past few decades. Along with the increased boat traffic, the size of motorboats continues to grow, particularly on our larger lakes. Where there are boats, there are boat wakes. Please join the Missouri State Highway Patrol in promoting wake courtesy to minimize the danger to others using our waterways, damage to docks and erosion to our shorelines. Operating a motorboat at "plowing" speed is necessary at times, but should not be the norm.

Please make note of these reminders so you are part of the solution and not part of the problem:

- Operate your boat at idle speed, or when you are safely able to do so, operate on plane. Do not continuously plow unless absolutely necessary.
- Boats that cause excessive wakes should always operate in the middle of the lake to allow their boat wake time and distance to lose energy.
- Plowing within cove locations is discouraged, unless safety or water sport activities require you to do so.

- Water sport activities requiring excessive boat wakes should be reserved for areas of our lakes where the danger to boaters, damage to docks or significant shoreline erosion is limited.
- Cruiser and houseboat owners and operators are a significant and important part of our boating communities, but these boat owners and operators require heightened awareness of the wake they are causing.
- Remember to be courteous. If you were in a small boat attempting to navigate your boat wake, or you owned a dock that has to survive your boat wake, would you be operating in the same manner? Treat other boaters and property owners as you would want to be treated.
- Causing harm to another person or their property with an excessive boat wake may subject you to enforcement action or civil liability.

The great state of Missouri has many beautiful waterways, all of which allow for a wide variety of boating activities. Responsible and courteous boaters help make our waterways safe and enjoyable for everyone's use.



Bagnell Dam Report

The lake level was 654.4 generation of 3,500 CFS (cubic feet per second) throughout the week for a lake level of 654.5 by the weekend. Surface temperature at Bagnell Dam was 48 degrees. Truman Lake was at the 708.1 level. To note: the Lower Lake is from the dam to the 22-mile mark; Mid-Lake is from the 22- to 44-mile mark, the Upper Osage is from the 44-mile mark to the Route 65 Bridge.

Tournament Results

Scott and Codi Stonitsch won the Ozark Mountain Team Trail tournament last Saturday with five bass weighing 24.91 pounds.

Bagnell Dam spillway/Osage River

Water clarity: Clear. Crappie: Good on jigs and minnows set below a bobber around current breaks. Walleye: Good on 3-inch swimbaits in the spillway area. Paddlefish: Snagging has been good.

Lower Lake

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Excellent on Alabama rigs, suspending jerkbaits and Wiggle Wart crankbaits along steep banks. Crappie: Good on jigs 3 to 12 feet deep along secondary points and flats in backs of coves. White bass: Good on jigs around shad schools in backs of coves.

Gravois

Water clarity: Clear. Black bass: Good on crankbaits, suspending jerkbaits, Alabama rigs and jigs along laydowns on secondary and main lake points. Crappie: Good on small swimbaits and minnows along secondary points. White bass: Fair trolling crankbaits along the main channel.

Mid-Lake

Water clarity: Stained. Black bass: Excellent on suspending jerkbaits, Wiggle Wart crankbaits and spinnerbaits along steep banks. Crappie: Good on jigs 8 to 10 feet deep around shad schools and brush in coves.



Grand Glaize

Water clarity: Stained. Black bass: Fair on crankbaits, suspending jerkbaits and jigs along channel banks, secondary points and flats in coves. Crappie: Good on jigs 4 to 6 feet deep around brush in backs of coves.

Niangua

Water clarity: Murky on the upper end and clear on the lower end. Black bass: Fair on crankbaits and Chatterbaits along channel swing banks. Crappie: Fair on jigs 2 to 15 feet deep around brush along main and secondary points.

Upper Osage

Water clarity: Stained turning to murky farther up lake. Black bass: Good on Wiggle Wart crankbaits and Alabama rigs along main lake points or suspending jerkbaits and jigs along rock banks and brush in coves. Crappie: Fair on minnows 10 to 12 feet deep in brush. Catfish: Good tight-lining cut shad on the main channel.

Truman Dam spillway

Water clarity: Stained. Crappie: Good on jigs in the dead-water channel. Catfish: Fair on cut shad in the spill-way.






