To keep the Dogwood trees in full bloom, the Camdenton Area Chamber of Commerce has purchased 500 Dogwood saplings. The trees were purchased from the Forrest Keeling Nursery. According to the Missouri Department of Conservation, the majority of a tree's feeder roots are in the upper 6 inches of soil where they complete with grass roots for oxygen, moisture, and nutrients. Feeder roots thrive on soil that is loose, moist and fertile–conditions often lacking in soils around homes.

They recommend the following:

- 1. Plant your tree as soon as possible.
- If you are not able to plant it the day you receive it, place it in the vegetable drawer of your refrigerator. DO NOT FREEZE.
- 3. Select a planting site that will give the tree room to grow and has the correct light conditions.
- 4. Dig the initial hole as deep as the root system and about a foot wide.
- Remove the seedling from the bag and place it in the hole.
 Make sure the roots are spread out and are not crowded or bent.
- 6. Crumble the soil back around the roots and pack firmly with your hands.
- 7. Water the tree thoroughly to finish packing the soil around the roots.
- 8. Mulch the planting area to a depth of 2 inches and to a radius of 9-12 inches around the tree.
- New trees need the equivalent of 1 to 1.5 inches of rainfall per week during the first four years.







74TH ANNUAL DOGWOOD GRAND MARSHAL

Larry Peterson




The Camdenton Area Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce Larry Peterson as this year's Grand Marshal.

Larry Peterson, the Grand Marshal of the 74th Annual Dogwood Festival, has deep roots in Camden County that span over five generations. His mother's family has lived in the area since the 1850s, with his great-grandfather, Henry W. Chalfant, making a lasting impact as an attorney in Old Linn Creek. Henry founded H.W. Chalfant's Abstracts in 1887, which later became Chalfant and Tompkins Abstracts. The family business thrived for generations until Larry and his wife, Lisa, retired in 2019, selling it to Alpha Title in Kansas City. Larry continues to assist the company as needed.

Born in Kansas City, KS, Larry moved to Camdenton in 1957, where he attended school and graduated from Camdenton High School in 1968. After marrying Lisa in 1977, they made Camdenton and the Lake area their permanent home. They have one daughter, Lauren, who lives in St. Charles, Missouri, along with their granddog, Olenna.



Larry's life has been defined by service. After three years of college, he began his military career in 1972 with the U.S. Army, serving with the Army Security Agency in Turkey. He remains active in reunions with fellow ASA veterans. Larry's professional career in the land title business spans over 40 years, and his deep interest in Camden



County's history has led him to become an active community member and to some a "town historian".

Larry is involved in the Camdenton Rotary, serves in the music program at Camdenton United Methodist Church, works as a funeral assistant at Allee-Holman-Howe Funeral Home, and volunteers at the Lamb House Food Bank. Additionally, he's a member of the Lake of the Ozarks Scandinavian Club and has served as an election judge during recent County elections.

Having lived in the community for so many years, Larry has witnessed a number of changes over time. He remembers the significant transformation of the Camdenton Square in the late 1950s and early 1960s, particularly when U.S. Highway 54 was widened. He also recalls the days when the square had just one "flashing" stoplight, a far cry from the multiple traffic signals now found throughout the city. One of the notable firsts in the area was the introduction of "drive-through" banking at First National Bank, which offered a single drive-through lane—a feature that still exists today at the bank's previous location. Over the years, Larry has watched many "mom-and-pop" resorts and fishing camps evolve into the condo complexes that now line the lake as well as the amount of traffic that has increased in the area.

While it may not be an organized event, Halloween on Panoramic Drive has become a beloved tradition in the community. Each year, Larry, Lisa, and their neighbors welcome between 800 and 1,000 trick-or-treaters to their homes, making it a special occasion for the entire area.

When asked about his thoughts on the Camdenton community, Larry described it as a "safe, friendly town with a great school system, low taxes compared to other areas, and an overall a great place to live."




Robert & Beatrice Teahan






